A marriage bond was not a marriage license. When one, or both parties were not well known locally, the civil or religious authorities asked for a guarantee of credentials. Friends of the applicant would sign a bond or guarantee. If the marriage should prove to be improper, that is to say, it had connections of consanguinity or of affinity or some other defect, then the bondsman would be fined.

CORNISH QUEST

On a recent trip to England I spent a few days ancestor hunting and would like to tell you a bit about it. My first destination was Shebbear College in North West Devon, in rolling, hidden, unspoilt country, so hidden that we had a little trouble finding it up narrow one-way roads, much to my husband Mac's dismay, and had to get directions from Cornish folk with delightful accents.

I had written that we were coming, and also had phoned the day before, so they were expecting us, and we were welcomed very warmly. The headmaster's secretary brought in a tray of coffee and biscuits, and one of the masters who had lived in Canada for two years, and was planning to retire to northern Ontario, dropped in to visit with us. Then we were taken to the dining room for lunch, sitting with the headmaster and the chaplain, who was also the archivist.

The Bible Christian Society was founded at Shebbear in 1815, an offshoot of Methodism, and was the start of the greatest religious revival the West Country had ever seen. My father, Percy Mallett, attended Shebbear College in the 1890's but, much to my disappointment, the registers for those years were missing. However, something else unexpectedly appeared. My grandfather, Rev. John Mallett, was a Bible Christian minister for over 25 years, and served in Shebbear town from 1876 to 1879. I had a list of his circuits which I had received from the Methodist Archives in Manchester. His last six years were marked "wpc", which had no meaning for me. The headmaster said it meant "without pastoral charge". He looked up the minutes for London for 1900, my grandfather s last charge being Tottenham, and here is an excerpt: "with the exception of the financial difficulty at Forest Hill, and a passing cloud at Tottenham, all the pastors had experiences of joy and success to relate". We all had a good laugh at the delicacy of the wording, and speculated on what the "passing cloud" could have been. The archivist assured me that it wouldn't have been sexual or he would

assured me that it wouldn't have been sexual or he would have been dismissed. The headmaster gladly made a copy of the page for me. A history of Shebbear College was published in 1987 called "A School Apart", which I was pleased to buy, and which I am enjoying reading.

Near Bodwin, we stopped at Lanivet where my father was born, and looked at the old 15th c. church on an ancient site with very old 10th and 13th c. crosses. This had been a crossroads, and an important centre in Celtic times and in the Dark Ages.

I spent two days in the Truro Record Office. I had written to ask for a list of their holdings, as Dr. Warren had suggested, and was sent six pamphlets as well as the suggestion that I book a seat for the days I wanted. It was very satisfying there, as you are looking at the original

records and documents.

The marriage records proved to be very fruitful. It was interesting to note that they mostly signed with their mark in the 18th century, and had to have the consent of their parents and (or) master, if under the age of 21. When I ordered some parish registers starting in 1549. I couldn't read them, so had to exchange them for transcripts. The chap at the desk said that they were really quite easy to read as they had only been written in 1624! Burials proved to be most interesting. I made a long list of the common causes of death in those days with the different wordings for the same thing; e.g. "old age, decay of nature, atrophy, natural decay, visitor of God". There were many mine accidents, childbirth deaths and whole pages of typhoid epidemics. One baby's death was marked "consumption or WANT'. Another was marked "unbaptized" - "This child being unbaptized was buried with form sanctioned by bishop of diocese".

In the local record offices you can look at the original documents, such as wills, to see if they are the right ones before asking for a copy, which is only 90p (about \$1.70), considerably cheaper than in London. There was only one book of Tithe Apportionments 1837-1840. In this book I found the land where my two great great grandfathers were yeomen farmers. The page lists the owner of the land, occupiers, plan number, name and description of lands and premises, state of cultivation, quantities in statute measure, amount of rent charge to vicar and to impropriators and names of impropriators. I was able to look at the huge old canvas-backed map that went with it, laid out on a large map table. Here I was able to see the names of the lands; e.g. "Twelvewood' (the place on my great grandmother's birth record), "Northwood Down", "Middle Hammett" etc., and see the places in relation to St. Neot, so that when I went there, I could look at the actual land. The closest I could get to a copy of the old map was an Ordinance Survey Map of 1907.

I was pleased to find two members of the LDS church working in the Truro Record Office. They were a retired couple from Texas, giving six months to the gathering of information. I also met a man from Dartmouth who was there for the same two days so the three of us had lunch and dinner together. He invited us to visit him, which we did, and found Dartmouth to be a most picturesque place. He is a genealogical advisor and gives workshops on the West Country.

Next we travelled down to Southern Cornwall. The interesting places are often off on those little narrow one-way roads. Chysauster Ancient Village is the remains of a walled village from the Iron Age period, and is situated on top of a hill. It was a lovely sunny day and as we stood there amidst the ancient houses, all silent and peaceful, and looking down at the landscape before us, we could almost feel the presence of ancient times. Farther on, I walked up a hill-side to the Merry Maidens' Stone Circle, and stood in the middle all alone, and wondered what tales those ancient stones could tell. I am just mentioning these places out of historical interest, and am not planning on tracing my family tree back that far!

We then turned north towards St. Neot, where I have my father's line back to about 1730. I stood on Treverbyn Bridge, built in 1412 over the River Fowey, next to the water mill, on the land where my grandfather was born. The parish church in St. Neot has the oldest stained glass windows in Cornwall, and many ancient crosses in the graveyard.

Last year I wrote a letter to the editor of the Cornish Times in Liskeard and had three replies. One of the replies was from a Jean Mallett in West Moors, Wimborne, Dorset, so this was our next destination. We spent two profitable days there, Mac golfing with the people who owned our beautiful guest house, I copying information at Jean's. She is in touch with three other people who are researching my line, and had made out a genealogical chart for the Malletts, so I was able to fill in quite a few blanks in mine. Jean had also written a history of the name Mallett, which was very interesting.

After a visit to the Isle of Wight we set off for London. I was glad that I had my red St. Catherine's House guide with me. It mentioned that it got busy about 11am, so we arrived first thing in the morning, and found hardly anyone there, so we were able to get a lot done. On the back cover of the pamphlet it shows the floor plan, which was easy to follow and was very helpful. The births are right inside the entrance, with the dates on the ends of the green open shelves, four books to a year. Deaths are farther in and marriages in red at the back.

Me found Mac's grandfather s birth right away, and paid our 5 pounds to have the certificate sent. When we left at noon there were long lineups waiting to pay. The trouble at St. Catherine's House is that you cannot see the original registers, only the indexes of events. If you find the right entry in the index, you have to buy the actual certificate to get further information. The problem is that before 1911, for births, the name of the mother is not shown and before 1912, for marriages, the name of the spouse is not shown. The latter proved a difficulty for me in trying to trace my grandfather's second marriage. I was left with five probable possibilities and numerous possibilities. I would have had to pay for each certificate until I found the right one. I may get my new friend in Dartmoor to check them out in Truro and Exeter Record Offices the next time he's there.

After lunch we went to Somerset House to look for my grandfather's will. As soon as we stepped through the door, a pleasant gentleman came up and asked if we had been there before and what exactly we were looking for. The registers we needed were right in from the door. As it was not busy and the books mostly covered a whole year, within half an hour we had found the will. I hadn't found his death at St. Catherine's House because I hadn't gone back far enough, thinking he had died much later. The index entry for wills has lots of information, and you have to pay only 25p (\$.45) to look at the original, from which you can make an abstract of the important parts or you can get it photocopied for 25p a page. Having Mac with me to lift those heavy books up and down was a great help.

I left England with a sense of having accomplished much, and with the thrill of having visited the actual places where my forebears had been born and had lived.

Dear Santa.

Don't bring me new dishes, I don't want a new kind of game. Genealogists have peculiar wishes; I just want a sur-name. A new washing machine would be great, but not the desire of my life. I've just found an ancestor's birthdate; now I need the name of his wife. My heart doesn't yearn for a ring that would put a diamond to shame, what I want is much cheaper; please give me Mary's last name. To see my heart singing with joy, give me a clue that I can trace Or give me a genealogist's toy; a surname, with dates and a place.

Researching at the Public Archives of Nova Scotia.

I spent four full days at the Archives in Halifax reading, copying and note-taking information related to my genealogy. The staff there were knowledgeable and helpful. I had identified Hoyt and Purdy genealogies, held at the N.S. archives, in the book "Genealogical Research in Nova Scotia" by Terence Punch before I left Nanaimo, and started my research by asking for them. They were promptly produced along with recent revisions to the four volume Purdy genealogies, received by the Archives only a few days before I got there, and which they hadn't yet had time to examine. These revisions up-dated the Purdy genealogies down to present generations in many cases.

They also had a copy of a vast Hoyt genealogy of 1871 purportedly of all the North American Hoyts to that time, including my grandparents. The numbers of Hoyts (in various spellings including Hoit, Hait, Hayt, Haight, Hight) listed in the 1871 genealogy were over 9500, "including daughters but not children of daughters bearing other surnames, nor wives and husbands of descendants", and it was far from complete except very nearly so in the first four of the eleven generation listed. Over 7000 used the spelling Hoyt.

Practically all Hoyts in North America appear to have derived from either Simon or John Hoyt (no relationship known, but quite possible). Simon Hoyt, from whom I derive eleven generations later, was born about 1590 and came to New England in 1628, one of a small boatload of English Puritans. He was probably from Somerset, England where the Hoyt name is recorded back to 1400.

A sixth generation descendant of Simon s. Col. Jesse Hoyt migrated to the Annapolis Valley, N.S. in 1783 from Connecticut, after becoming extremely unpopular by serving on the British side in the American Revolution, as did many others who became known as the United Empire Loyalists.

My father, a descendant of Jesse's, came from Bridgetown, N.S. to Nanaimo about 1910 establishing the Hoyt name here. I now know my Hoyt ancestory back to Simon, completely.

My grandfather, Alfred Hoyt married Mary Purdy whose lineage I was able to trace all the way back to Francis Furdy born c.1587, who was in Connecticut in 1635. Her grandfather and at least two of his brothers (and probably his father, emigrated from Connecticut as Loyalists to the Annapolis Valley after the Revolution. However, her own father and family moved back to New England about 1005, leaving my grandmother behind with husband and family in Eridgetown.

An even earlier root of mine in the Annapolis region is back through my great grandmother, Maria Doucet, who married my greatgrandfather, George Hoyt, and was from an old Acadian family in Digby Jounty, N.S. I didn't have time to pursue her lineage back to its Acadian origin but did determine that the first Acadian Doucet was Major Germain Doucet who arrived in Acadia (N.S.) c.1632, but was expelled subsequently by "victorious" British Forces, and returned to france. However, a son, Pierre Doucet, took refuge in Quebec, later to return to Port Royal. In the later Acadian expulsion the Doucets were removed to Massachusets, where they were "badly treated" for the third time, returning to Digby County c.1770 after the expulsion was lifted. This time they pioneered (permanently) the settlement of Clare, which is where my great grandmother's family came from.

After consolidating the Hoyt and Purdy information I obtained at the Archives in Halifax, I intend to investigate the Doucet lineage and history further, as it should prove to be most interesting.

Researching in Russia

Daniel M. Schlyter wrote an interesting article in the Polish Genealogical Society Newsletter, Fall 1988, p. 40, "Soviet Government to Allow Genealogical Inquiries." In the article he states "--- the Soviet Embassy in Washington D.C. announced in the summer of 1988 that they will accept requests for research in the USSR Arkady Parshenko, first Secretary and Consul of the Soviet embassy in Washington D.C. said "I have just received word from Moscow that Genealogical Research in the Soviet Union is now completely opened. Persons wishing to do genealogical research should direct their requests to the State Archives in Moscow." This statement was made to Dr. Sallyann Sack, and editor of Avotaynu, the International Review of Jewish Genealogy. No information was included about terms under which the Soviet government will do genealogical research. (Avotaynu, Vol.4/no.3,p. 2; Summer 1988) It is not known how this will be handled or how long it will take for the requests to be answered. Direct inquiries to: Boris Ivanovich Kaptelov; Central State Archives; Bolshaya Pirogouskaya U/., 119817 Moscow, Union of Soviet Socialist Republiscs. You must give specific information: Town; approximate date of event; religion of ancestor, ethnic group of ancestor. Be specific.

HOW TO OBTAIN BIRTH, DEATH, MARRIAGE, DIVORCE & ADOPTION RECORDS. 1989. By Eugene F. FERRARO, available from Marathon Press, 13575 Martinique Dr., Chino Hills, CA 91709. Soft-cover, staple bound, 8½x11 inches, 37 pages, \$9.95 plus \$1.75 shipping.

The obtaining of vital records is of prime importance in research and this book enables the researcher to more easily and quickly obtain them. All 50 states plus the District of Columbia, the Virgin Islands, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands are covered individually and alphabetically. Under each state the book lists the type of event (birth, death, marriage, divorce). the cost of a copy, the address to write to, and remarks, which specify the periods covered in the records, the phone number of the agency, and other miscellaneous items. A final section discusses foreign records. Appendices give Social Security prefixes for each state and possession, addresses for each State Capitol and Agencies with jurisdiction over adoptions, and the status of adoption records by state, listing court jurisdiction, availability of birth certificate at maturity, and age of maturity. Nearly all genealogists will find this book to be extremely useful in obtaining vital information.
