... More Yankee Quebecois

In the March issue of Fleur de Lys, the story of Deerfield captives John Stebbins and family was put forth. Far from being the only prisoners to remain in Canada, the children of John Stebbins share this distinction with several other individuals.

The Hurst Family

The Deerfield raid of Feb. 29, 1704 caught most of the inhabitants of the town unawares. Among these was the "widow" Hurst and her family. Mary Jeffreys had married Thomas Hurst some twenty years before and had borne him seven children before his death on Feb. 9, 1702. Thomas' point of origin in England is unknown to us today. Although he was apparently the first of his line in America, the possibility exists that he may have been related to James Hurst, the first tanner of Plymouth colony. The latter Hurst had been present at Plymouth in 1632 and had been among the purchasers of Dartmouth, Massachusetts. He died in December of 1657, making mention of his wife and the seven grandchildren which he had through his daughter Patience Cobb. Thus the relationship between James and Thomas Hurst remains conjecture.

It is known that Thomas was present at Hadley, Mass. in 1678. There he enjoyed the condition of freeman. He was later to move to Deerfield as part of the permanent settlement following the Bloody Brook massacre. It was here that he and his wife settled to raise their children. Their family numbered four sons and three daughters: Sarah, b. July 26, 1685; Elizabeth, b. Aug. 15, 1687; Thomas, b. June 12, 1691; Ebenezer, b. Oct. 1 and died Oct. 10, 1693; Hannah, b. May 26, 1695; a second Ebenezer, b. May 7, 1698; and Benoni, born posthumously April 29, 1702.

No members of Mary Hurst's family were actually killed in the raid of 1704. Their house, valued at twenty pounds, was burnt. The entire family was taken. Later, the young Benoni either died or was killed on the trek to Canada, leaving Mary with two sons and three daughters to accompany her into captivity.

Life among the French was not agreeable to the two eldest daughters for they were ransomed and returned to New England, at least according to lists composed many years after the raid, and quoted in Sheldon's History of Deerfield, Mass., (vol. II, p. 219). The work would also have the mother, Mary Hurst, ransomed and returned to New England-- but several church acts speak differently.

Sarah Hurst may well have returned to her home province. As for her mother and sister Elizabeth, Tanguay cites proof to the contrary. Marie-Jeanne Jeffreys, widow of Thomas "Hurt" of Deerfield, New England, married Oct. 29, 1710, at Montreal, William Perkins, son of William Perkins and Mary Lowd of Lincolnshire, England. No children are known to have been born of the union.

Elizabeth Hurst was to bear her husband Thomas Bécraft two sons. The couple were married Oct. 3, 1712, at Montreal, the groom being the Son of Thomas Bécraft and Elizabeth Gay of Norwich, (New?) England. Nine months to the day, after the marriage, a son William was born and baptized at Montreal. He was followed, one year later, June 7, 1714, by another son, Thomas.

The widow Hurst had apparently elected to stay in Canada when offered the possibility of returning home. Of her four remaining children, only Hannah left no trace in Canada. Ebenezer, given the baptismal name Antoine-Nicolas, was baptized Dec. 6, 1705. His elder brother Thomas was baptized at the mission of Notre-Dame-de-Lorette, Oct. 19, 1705. From his first wife, Marguerite Thibault, Thomas had no children. Remarrying on Feb. 28, 1718, at Montreal,

### Rising / Raizenne

The Raizennes of Quebec are yet another example of a family group that traces its origins to Yankee New England. Unlike the Hursts, one cannot link the captive Englishman with his parents in New England. The comparative rarity of the name "Rising" in Massachusetts, however, leads us to posit a lineage with a high degree of certitude.

James Rising, born in 1617, sailed from London in 1635. His destination was Bermuda where England had established a colony some years before. The island was apparently not to his liking since, several years later, we find him in Massachusetts. He married Elizabeth Hinsdale, daughter of Robert Hinsdale and Elizabeth Woodward of Medfield, Mass., on July 7, 1657.

Rising was apparently of the foot-looses sort, as he once again leaves for Bermuda, only to return to New England where he would first live at Salem, and then at Windsor, Connecticut. He would be voted an inhabitant of Windsor in 1668. It was here that

his wife would die the following year. A second wife, Martha, would live until April 20, 1674, when James Rising would become a widower for the second time.

Two children are known to have been born to James and Elizabeth: James and John. Others may have followed, but their names are unknown.

James Sr. was the keeper of the ferry at Windsor for several years before moving to Suffield, Conn. in 1679. It was there that he died Sept. 11, 1688. No other New England settlers of this name can be found-- thus leading to the conclusion that James is the ancestor of all individuals of this name in early colonial times.

James Rising, Jr. died a bachelor July 24, 1690. His brother John, however, married twice and fathered 18 children. It was in all probability one of these children whom the Indians captured at Deerfield in 1704.

Josiah Rising, the captive, was born at Deerfield, Feb. 2, 1694, and was therefore 10 years old when taken to Canada. He was baptized Dec. 10, 1706 at Lac-des-Deux-Montagnes, and give the name Ignace. The Indians had already given him their own adopted name: Sho-en-tak-wa-ni.

"Ignace Raizenne" took a wife when he was 21 years old. On July 29, 1715, in the same church where he had been baptized, Josiah/Ignace married Tou-a-to-go-wach, an English captive whose baptismal name was Elizabeth. C. Alice Baker, New England genealogist, succeeded in identifying Elizabeth as Abigail Nimbs, daughter of Godfrey Nimbs and Mehitable Smeed, also taken from Deerfield and —— baptizes in Canada June 15, 1704.

There is, however, room to doubt Ms. Baker's conclusions on Tou-a-to-go-wach's identity. Among Ignace and Elizabeth's children was one Anastasie who took two husbands during her lifetime. At her second marriage, to Pierre Castonguay, at Montreal in 1750, she is listed as the widow of Jean-Baptiste Sabourin, as well as the daughter of Ignace Resenne and deceased Elizabeth Steben.

The name Steben, as found in the marriage act, is in direct conflict with the Baker theory. One would suppose that Elizabeth were yet another of John Stebbins missing children. John and Dorothy Stebbins had but two daughters, Abigail and Thankful, both of whom are accounted for in Canadian baptismal and marriage acts-- both their own and those of their children.

We must look to the list of Deerfield captives who never returned to their home province. Among these is to be found the name of Elizabeth Stevens, aged about 20 at the time of the raid. The leap from "Stevens" to "Steben" would be a small one for a French-speaking cleric who may well have been aware of the existence of an entire brood on Stebbins/Stebenne children in the French colony.

At the time of the marriage of Ignace and Elizabeth, Ignace would have been 21 years old, while his bride would have been 31. That a bride should be ten years older than her husband is unusual but certainly not impossible. Abigail <sup>was</sup> Nimbs two years old at the time of her capture. Following the Baker theory, our bride and groom of 1715 would have been aged 13 and 21 respectively-- a highly unlikely state of affairs.

We are led to conclude, therefore, that Tou-a-to-go-wach, while still a Deerfield captive, was more likely Elizabeth Stevens than Abigail Nimbs.

Sho-en-tak-wa-ni and Tou-a-to-go-wach would have four children: three daughters, and one son who would carry on the Raizenne name.

In this family, English captives seem to have gravitated towards each other. Sara Enneson, the mother of the two Sabourins who married Raizenne children, was herself an Englishwoman from Boston.

J.B.-Jerome and his wife had 8 children between November 1762 and 1775. All reached adulthood, although only two married. The other six, five girls and a boy, all entered the religious life.

Once again, it fell to a single son to perpetuate the Raizenne name. Ignace did pass the name on-- as a son Clet was born in 1806 at St-Eustache. This son would marry Feb. 8, 1831 at Rigaud, to Rose-Sophie Gauthier.

## French

A Deerfield captive who left at least one illustrious descendant in French Canada was a man whose name, paradoxically enough, was French.

The first of this line to appear in New England was John French who came to Northampton, Mass., probably from Rehoboth, Mass., before the year 1676. It is not certain that he ever lived at Deerfield. We do know, however, that he held lands there upon his death, Feb. 1, 1697.

By his wife, a former \_\_\_\_ Kingsley, daughter of John of Rehoboth, were born seven children: 1) Thomas, b. 1657; 2) John, b. 1658; m. 1678 Mary Palmer, and settled at Rehoboth; 3) Mary, b. 1660, m. 1678, Samuel Stebbins, divorced 1692; 4) Hannah, b. 1661; m. Francis Keet of Northampton and Deerfield; 5) Elizabeth, b. 1669, m. Samuel Pomroy; 6) Jonathan, settled at Northampton; and lastly, Samuel, d. Sept. 8, 1683.

The eldest son, Thomas, was church deacon and remained active in Deerfield affairs for the greater part of his life. He was one of the first settlers of the town and lived on lot #30 with his wife and large family. It was here that the entire group were surprised by the 1704 attack.

At the time of the raid, Thomas French was serving as town clerk. This was not the first post which he had held, however, since he had been a town selectman as early as 1686. He was still selectman in 1689, and was re-elected to the position in 1693. In 1695 he was chosen to be town clerk for the first time. On Aug. 3, 1699, he was named to a committee whose job it was to construct a grist mill. By 1701-02, he was helping to set tax rates for the town of Deerfield.

As has been stated, French was the town clerk when the French and Indian force fell upon the town. Although he personally lost a good deal in the raid, with respect to his estate and his family, Thomas French's record books remained miraculously intact.

When the invaders retreated from Deerfield, Thomas French, his wife and four children had been made captives. Their youngest child, John, aged but 28 days on the morning of the raid, was killed on the spot. Mary Catlin French, Thomas' wife since their wedding on Oct. 18, 1683, would meet her death on March 9, 1704, on the forced march to Canada.

Thomas French stayed in Canada for two years, until Ensign Jonathan Sheldon of Massachusetts succeeded in effecting a prisoner exchange. On May 30, 1706, French, with his eldest daughter Mary (born 1686), in the company of 42 other captives, began the trip by boat down the St. Lawrence. After much delay, which included a stop at Port Royal, the captives arrived at Boston on August 2, 1706.

French would make his way back to Deerfield where he would once again immerse himself in local affairs. On Nov. 30, 1706, the year of his return, he would make the long trip to Boston to solicit a new pastor for the Deerfield church. The voyage would be made in the company of Ensign Jonathan Sheldon and Captain Jonathan Wills.

The expedition was apparently a success, as we later find French on a committee to build the past<sup>or</sup> Rev. Jonathan William, a new house. Twelve years later, Thomas French is chosen to help discuss Rev. Williams' salary with him.

In 1721, French helps determine the seating arrangement in the new meeting house.

In a few years, after the death of Mr. Williams, a new pastor would be needed. The process would not be without its problems,

however, since the ultimate choice, Benjamin Pierpont, a recent graduate of Yale, would spend but four years in the town. By 1731, dissatisfaction with his pastorship would lead to the calling of yet another minister, John Warren -- who never did come to the town. By early 1732, the minister-selection committee, of which Thomas French was still a part, succeeded in obtaining a new pastor, Jonathan Ashley.

French's tenure on this last-named committee would be one of his last earthly acts. He would die the following spring, April 3, 1733, at the age of 76.

French had not spent his last years alone, as he left a widow, Hannah Edwards, previously the widow of Benoni Stebbins. Both French and his second wife had been widowed in the raid of 1704. The couple were married Feb. 16, 1709. Hannah would survive her second husband by nearly 2½ years, dying in turn Sept. 7, 1735.

Thomas French had left three children in Canada: Freedom, born Nov. 20, 1692; Martha, born May 12, 1695; and Abigail, born Feb. 28, 1698. This last daughter left no traces of her passage in Canada. Her two sisters, however, each integrated themselves into the local population and took husbands.

In the event that foreigners were baptized into the Catholic Church in Canada, new baptismal names were used to distinguish the old individual from the new. Often, however, new names were given based on a phonetic resemblance to the old. It was in this way that Freedom French became Francoise, or more accurately, Marie-Francoise French. She was baptized at Montreal, April 6, 1706, and had as godfather, Thomas de Joncaire, army officer. Seven years later, on Feb. 6, 1713, at Montreal, Marie-Francoise would marry Jean Daveluy,

son of Paul Daveluy and Elizabeth Haguin.

Between the years 1714 and 1738, Marie-Francoise would bear her husband eleven children. Two would grow into adulthood to take spouses -- Marguerite, bapt. Aug. 10, 1722, Montreal; m. Feb. 19, 1748, Montreal, to Augustin Gautier (Augustin & Marie-Joseph Jouet). The second child, Jean-Baptiste, bapt. March 22, 1724, would marry Augustin's sister Marie-Judith at Varennes, Feb. 20, 1748.

Marie-Francoise's sister was destined to have a slightly more colorful history. After her capture, she was kept by the Indians for some time and then given to the Sisters of Notre-Dame at Montreal. Almost three years after her capture, she was baptized at Montreal (Jan. 23, 1707). Her godfather was Francois Clairambault Daigremont, naval commissioner and assistant to the "Intendant" of the colony.

At the somewhat tender age of 16, she was married, at Montreal, to Jacques Roy (Pierre & Catherine Duchesne) from Laprairie. He was aged 22 at the time. The marriage was celebrated Nov. 24, 1711. Nine children would be born of this union between 1713 and 1727.

It was shortly thereafter that Marthe-Marguerite French, barely past the age of 30, was left a widow. She would marry once again-- May 4, 1733, at St-Laurent-de-Montreal, to Jean-Louis Menard, b. 1702, son of Jacques Menard and Marie-Anne Roy from St-Sepulchre parish, town of St-Omer, Artois, France. Yet another three children would be born to Marthe-Marguerite from this second marriage.

Unlike her sister, Marthe-Marguerite would have the good fortune of seeing the majority of her children reach adulthood.

Marie-Louise Menard, daughter of the second marriage, would carry on the family tradition of exceptionally fertile unions. Her husband, Joseph-Amable Plessy-dit-Belair, was himself one of 21 children all born to the same mother. Into the Plessy(Plessis)-Menard household, 17 children would be born. A son, born during the year that the conquest of Canada was finalized, 1763, was destined to bring honor to himself and to his family. On March 3rd of that year, Joseph-Octave Plessis came into the world. The boy would grow up and be ordained a priest on March 11, 1786. At the age of 42 he would be called to the episcopacy, being consecrated Bishop of Quebec on Jan. 25, 1806. He would hold the position for many years, before dying at Quebec Dec. 4, 1825.

Had old Thomas French been capable of looking into the future, he doubtlessly would not have believed the fate in store for his modest family and their descendants.

## Gill

The fourth Yankee captive which we will consider left a sizable progeny in French Canada. Samuel Gill was but 10 years old when he was abducted by the Indians from his home at Salisbury, New England. Emma Lewis Coleman (New England Captives Carried to Canada) has identified him as the son of Sgt. Samuel Gill and his wife Sarah Worth. Born Sept. 16, 1687, he was abducted from his parents' home at Salisbury, June 10, 1697.

We know few details about Samuel's life, apart from the fact that his Indian captors chose to keep him among them. Indian custom allowed for replacing of killed or missing family members with captives taken in war. This is perhaps what happened to Samuel, since, ca. 1715, he takes another Abenaki captive as his wife. The woman, Rosalie \_\_\_\_\_ may have been of the same Yankee origin as was Samuel.

In any event, the couple remained at St-Francois-du-Lac, the parish set up for civilized Indians on the south shore of the St. Lawrence. The couple had at least four sons: 1) Joseph-Louis who married twice, once to an Abenaki woman, Jeanne, and later to one Suzanne Gamelin; 2) Francois, married at St-Francois in 1768 to Anne Labonte-Couturier; 3) Robert, married in 1774 to Louise Chenevert; and 4) Joseph-Piche, who married twice, both times to Indian women.

For the next 150 years, the family stayed in and about St-Francois-du-Lac, where the majority of the Gill descendants married and raised their children.



NOTE: ALFRED AND HIS WIFE WERE IN THE WILD RICE AREA DURING THE 1880S AND 90S. SEVEN CHILDREN WERE BAPTIZED AT ST. BENEDICT DURING THAT TIME. LATER THEY MOVED TO THE GEORGETOWN, MINN. AREA. FROM THERE WE LOSE TRACK OF THEM.

FRANCOIS ALEXIS RICHARD, THE EIGHTH CHILD OF PIERRE RICHARD AND MARIE REINE DUCHARME, WAS BORN NOVEMBER 8, 1835 AU LAC ST-PAUL NEAR ST. ANGELE, QUEBEC. ALEX GREW TO MANHOOD IN THIS AREA. ON JULY 3, 1860 HE MARRIED AT ST. MAURICE, ELISABETH LEVASSEUR WHO WAS BORN IN 1841, THE DAUGHTER OF FRANCOIS LEVASSEUR AND LOUISE LANEUVILLE. ALEX AND ELISABETH FARMED IN THE ST. MAURICE AREA WHEN THEY WERE FIRST MARRIED. IN 1864 THEY MOVED TO MONT-CARMEL, APPROXIMATELY ELEVEN MILES WEST OF ST. MAURICE. IN THE FALL OF 1877 ALEX AND ELISABETH AND THEIR SEVEN CHILDREN MOVED TO HOLY CROSS MISSION, DAKOTA TERRITORY AND HOMESTEADED THE NORTH 80 OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER, SECTION 22, STANLEY TOWNSHIP. LATER ON THEY MOVED TO THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER, SECTION 9, PLEASANT TOWNSHIP. SATURDAY NIGHT, JULY 21, 1906 ELISABETH DIED. IN NOVEMBER, 1908 IN QUEBEC, ALEX MARRIED PHILOMENE, THE SISTER OF ELISABETH. OCTOBER 20, 1910 ALEX DIED IN QUEBEC. ALEX & ELISABETH ARE BURIED AT ST. BENEDICT, N. DAK.

PIERRE RICHARD - 1801 - 1867, SON OF JEAN BAPTISTE AND CHARLOTTE DESHAIES OF AU LAC ST. PAUL NEAR BECANCOURT, QUEBEC. PIERRE AND HIS BROTHER, JEAN-NOEL, WHO WAS THE FATHER OF MONSIGNOR LOUIS RICHARD, WERE BORN ON THE OLD ANCESTRAL LAND AT AU LAC ST. PAUL. IT HAD BEEN PIERRE'S GREAT GRANDFATHER, JOSEPH RICHARD, WHO HAD ESCAPED FROM ACADIE AND WAS THE FIRST TO ACQUIRE THIS LAND IN THE LATE 1750S. SO THIS LAND WENT FROM JOSEPH TO JEAN BAPTISTE TO JEAN BAPTISTE AND NOW TO PIERRE. TO THE WEST, THEIR NEIGHBOR WAS THEIR COUSIN, JOHNNY RICHARD, THE FATHER OF MARIA.

IN 1821 PIERRE MARRIED MARIE REINE DUCHARME AND HAD A FAMILY OF 12 CHILDREN. OF THIS FAMILY THERE WERE FOUR SONS, CYRILLE, GEORGE, THEOPHILE AND ALEX, MY GRANDFATHER. IN THE EARLY 1850S PIERRE, A WIDOWER, MADE ARRANGEMENTS WITH ONE SON TO REMAIN ON THE OLD LAND. THE CHOSEN SON WAS THEOPHILE, AND PIERRE PLANNED TO FINISH HIS OLD DAYS WITH HIM AND APPARENTLY EVERYTHING SEEMED TO BE PROPERLY ARRANGED FOR THIS PERPETUATION.

IN 1856 THEOPHILE MARRIED ELISABETH RHEAULT AND IN 1857 THIS COUPLE HAD A SET OF TWINS, PHILIPPE AND JULIEN. IT LOOKED GOOD FOR THE PERPETUATION OF THE RICHARD NAME ON THE OLD ANCESTRAL LAND, BUT FATE WAS NOT TO BE SO KIND FOR ON NOVEMBER 19, 1860 THEOPHILE, A YOUNG MAN OF 31, DIED.


IN 1863 THE WIDOW, ELISABETH, MARRIED PHILEAS HOULE AND SO IT WAS THAT THE ANCESTRAL LAND PASSED FROM THE RICHARD FAMILY TO THE HOULE FAMILY. ELISABETH RAISED THE RICHARD TWINS WITH HER SECOND FAMILY AND WHEN THEY BECAME OF AGE THEY HAD NO CLAIM TO THE LAND AS IT HAD BEEN SOLD. PHILIPPE AND HIS FAMILY ENDED UP IN NORTHERN QUEBEC IN THE COUNTY OF TEMISCAMINQUE AND TODAY HAS LIVING DESCENDANTS IN MONTREAL AND IN ONTARIO. JULIEN ENDED UP IN LITTLE FALLS, MINNESOTA, AND ALTHOUGH HE HAD A LARGE FAMILY THERE ARE NO RICHARD DESCENDANTS FROM JULIEN.

PIERRE UPON THE DEATH OF HIS SON, THEOPHILE, WAS LEFT WITHOUT A HOME. A SAD CIRCUMSTANCE FOR AN OLD MAN WHO HAD BEEN WELL OFF SHORTLY BEFORE, BUT HE HAD PICKED THE WRONG SON TO PASS HIS FORTUNE TO. HIS OLDER SONS, CYRILLE AND GEORGE, WHO WERE ESTABLISHED AT ST. MAURICE, CO. CHAMPLAIN, QUEBEC TOOK HIM INTO THEIR HOMES. IT WAS HERE HE DIED IN 1867 AND WHERE HE WAS BURIED.


CYRILLE HAD ONE SON BY THE NAME OF TANCRED WHO CAME TO NORTH DAKOTA AND LATER ON SETTLED IN POPLAR, MONTANA AREA. TODAY THERE ARE MANY DESCENDANTS OF TANCRED IN THIS MONTANA AREA.

GEORGE, THE OTHER SON OF PIERRE, RAISED A LARGE FAMILY IN THE ST. MAURICE AREA. ONE OF HIS SONS WAS FATHER JULIEN RICHARD. FATHER JULIEN ORIGINALLY SERVED IN THE ST. MAURICE PARISH BUT LATER ON ANSWERED THE CALL FOR FRENCH PRIESTS IN THE MANCHESTER, NEW HAMPSHIRE AREA. HE FOUNDED A FRENCH PARISH AT DOVER, N.H. IT WAS AT THIS TIME THAT HIS BROTHER, DR. JOSEPH HENRI, CAME TO DOVER AND STARTED HIS MEDICAL PRACTICE THERE. OTHER BROTHERS CAME TO THE AREA ALSO. THERE ARE MANY DESCENDANTS OF GEORGE IN THE NEW ENGLAND AREA. HOWEVER ONE EXCEPTION TO THESE MIGRATING BROTHERS WAS HYACINTHE, WHO MIGRATED TO WILD RICE, NORTH DAKOTA AND LATER BOTTINEAU, N. DAK. WHERE HE MARRIED AND WHERE TODAY MANY OF HIS DESCENDANTS ARE LIVING.

THE YOUNGEST SON OF DR. JOSEPH HENRI RICHARD IS PAUL ANDRE. IN 1976 I, FRANK RICHARD, SON OF EMILE, SON OF ALEX, SON OF PIERRE, MET MY SECOND COUSIN, PAUL ANDRE, IN NEW HAMPSHIRE. IT WAS AN EMOTIONAL MEETING OF COUSINS AFTER 100 YEARS APART. IT WAS PAUL ANDRE WHO PRESENTED ME WITH THE ONLY PICTURE OF MY GREAT GRANDFATHER, PIERRE. THIS HISTORICAL PICTURE HAD BEEN CAREFULLY PRESERVED THROUGH HIS FAMILY AND GIVEN TO HIM BY HIS FATHER. PAUL RECOGNIZED ME AS THE FAMILY HISTORIAN, AND BEQUEATHED ME THIS GREAT FAMILY RELIC. SO THE RICHARD STORY CONTINUES TO UNFOLD.
