


SOCIETY NOTES

The International Genealogical Workshop 1981 in Fredericton was a huge success despite the national mail strike. Predominant reasons for its wide acceptance were: full access for the three days to the New Brunswick Provincial Archives, cooperative speakers, a participating audience and an excellent hardworking organizational committee.

The 1982 version of the International Genealogical Workshop will be held in Fredericton, N.B. Saturday July 31, Sunday August 1 and Monday August 2, 1981. Advertisements will commence early in January and will be spread across North America. Further details will be forthcoming as soon as they are confirmed.

The 1983 version of the International Genealogical Workshop will be held in Saint John, N.B. Saturday July 30 to Monday August 1, 1983. This Workshop will be carried out in conjunction with the Loyalist activities for 1983.


Dan Johnson and his Vital Statistics Publication Committee (see Society Notes Newsletter #7) have issued a report on their work to date and the easiest and most accurate method of passing on this information is to include his letter in total:

"Transcriptions of vital statistics (including trials, accidents, notices of estate as well as marriages and obituaries) have recently been completed on the following newspapers for the period 29 Jan. 1784 to 31 Dec. 1829: New Brunswick Courier, City Gazette, St. John Gazette, The Star, Fredericton Telegraph, Gleaner & Northumberland Schediasma, St. Andrew's Herald, British Colonist, Times or True Briton, New Brunswick Chronicle, New Brunswick Extracts from Nova Scotia Newspapers 1813-1828.

"Papers currently being transcribed for the period prior 1830 include The Miramichi Mercury and Royal Gazette (including Mott's Royal Gazette which ran concurrently).

"It is estimated there will be over 5000 references at the time of completion. The resultant manuscript would exceed 300 single space type-written pages.

"I would recommend that we produce a series of smaller journals rather than a costly large volume. Each journal would contain about 1000 references with an index including complete names,



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geographical names, ships, and regiments. The journal would number about 70 pages in length, and, if produced 1000 issues at a time would reduce the cost per issue.

"The five volumes could be typed at the same time, with each journal being released or published when financially feasible.

"Distribution and marketing would require careful consideration and participation of all of the New Brunswick branches. Contrary to popular belief over one half of the references deal with other parts of the province, primarily in Kings and Charlotte Counties, but also Westmorland, Northumberland and York.

"We would welcome participation by all branches and individuals in completing this first series of journals. Any comments or suggestions would be appreciated.

"As per the time period before publication, no promises are made. Many hands will quicken the process. If any groups wish to extract vital information from newspapers, please contact me to avoid duplication and for clarification of what information is being extracted.

"Would it be possible to submit this report in our next newsletter?

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We wish to thank all contributors to the Newsletter, especially the members of the Saint John and the Southeastern Branches. We still have much material for inclusion in future Newsletters, but will be glad to receive any contributions from members.

It would be helpful, since we are now having the Newsletters printed in a different manner, for all contributions to be submitted "Camera Ready", typed on $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ paper with an inch margin on all sides. This will permit ready reproduction without the necessity of having the material re-typed.

This history of the Church of the Immaculate Conception at Cork, N.B. was published in a mid August 1943 edition of the "New Freeman" following the fire which destroyed the 3rd church on the site July 9, 1943.

HISTORY OF OUR CHURCH

Cork Settlement is one of the best and oldest known missions in the Diocese of Saint John and has a history interesting and unique. The name "CORK" chosen by the pioneers for their new home, stamps immediately the national origin of these people, and at the same time the love for their homeland, carried overseas, and implanted in the forests of New Brunswick. A cynic arriving in Cork for the first time and devois of Irish sentiment, sarcastically remarked: "Another injustice to Ireland", but in the minds of these homesick people, they were perpetuating in this country all that County Cork, with its Killarney Lakes and fertile soil meant to them.

THE PIONEERS:

About the year 1840, Irish settlers arrived in Saint John, went to Fredericton and went inland to take up homesteads between Lyons Stream and Gardiner's Creek. Here they started to clear the land and cultivate the rich soil and soon had homes constructed of the logs of the forest. Time went on and occasionally a priest went to visit them. The mission was attached to Fredericton and one of the earliest regular missionaries to Cork was Rev. James McDevitt.

FIRST CHURCH IN 1861:

One of the uppermost ideas in the minds of the Irish pioneers was to build a church, or as they always called it "THE CHAPEL". In 1851, after working out his homestead obligations John Russel received a grant of his land. When Father McDevitt wished to build a church he purchased two acres from John Russel who also donated two acres, making the four acres that is now the church property in Cork. The erection of the church was completed in 1861. But soon the hearts and fairth of the people were tested for in the great Saxby gale their beloved church was destroyed and all they had built up carried away by the wind.

The next day the first train passed through Cork on the newly constructed C.P.R. and men were called out to cut away the trees that had fallen during the gale. Thomas McKenna was the driver of the engine on this first trip. The building of the railway gave work to a great many and likewise placed the settlement on a transcontinental railway.

THE SECOND CHURCH

With courage undaunted, another church was planned larger and more modern than the first one, built of timbers no wind would carry away. It was plainly built without spire with gothic windows and certain exterior ornamentations to designate it as the HOUSE OF GOD. It was built to accommodate upwards of three hundred and had a small vestry on each side of the sanctuary.

A LARGER CHURCH:

During the pastorate of Rev. Donat LeBlanc, it was decided to build a new church in Cork. The site was chosen beside the old church which was now in need of extensive repairs.

Plans were made for a church 40' x 60' with a vestry and spire. Work was soon commenced and in 1902 a fine church was beautifully furnished interior with walls tinted in blue and white was completed. The large sanctuary was decorated with altar and beautiful statues of the Sacred Heart, the Immaculate Conception and St. Patrick. Later a bell was purchased for the church and the Bishop consecrated it naming it "MARY TIMOTHY" under which was inscribed "MAGNIFICAT ANIMA MEA".

ORDINATION:

One of the earliest outstanding events that took place in the church was the ordination by Right Rev. Timothy Casey, Bishop of Saint John, of Rev. Walter Donohoe, son of Mr. & Mrs. M. Donohoe. This took place on the feast of Saint Thomas, December 21st, 1910, with twenty priests present and a congregation filling the church. Rev. Francois Cormier was parish priest and Rev. Donat LeBlanc of Shediac was sponsor for the candidate for ordination. A severe frost had followed a thaw and the trees glistened with ice in the sunlight. A large procession of sleighs with many bells met the Bishop and guests at the train and escorted him to the church, three miles distant.

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BOOK REVIEW

PASSAMAQUODDY - Genealogies of West Isles Families,
Martha Ford Barto, Saint John, N. B., Lingley Printing
Company ltd., 1975, 228 p.

West Isles Parish of Charlotte County, New Brunswick consists of Deer Island, Indian Island, and a number of smaller islands in Passamaquoddy Bay. Originally it included Campobello, Grand Manan, and also Moose, Frederick and Dudley Islands which were transferred to the United States in 1817. New England fishermen began moving out of the islands in the 1760's; Captain William Owen brought a shipload of settlers to his grant of Campobello in 1770; and the Loyalist migration began in the 1780's. Many descendants of these families still live in the area.

Martha Ford Barto has compressed a wealth of research into the genealogies of the 84 Deer Island families in this book. These cover in general, a period from 1760 to about 1890, following the families as they move from island to island in their capacities as fishermen, shipbuilders and traders.

Mrs. Barto devotes more than a third of the book to the description and history of the West Isles, including many excerpts from letters, diaries and legal documents. Bibliographies for both the history and the genealogical research are provided.

This is a basic reference work for genealogists working in Charlotte County or northeastern Maine. It is also a valuable and entertaining addition to New Brunswick local history.

"THE MURDER OF CAPT. CLAYTON TILTON" by Daniel F. Johnson

Among the first settlers of Musquash Cove, Lancaster parish, St. John County, N.B. was CAPT. CLAYTON TILTON, a loyalist refugee. Capt. Tilton was born in Monmouth County, New Jersey where his family had resided for several generations.

At an early age he acquired the skills of ship carpenter and engaged in the coasting trade. In 1773, he purchased from John Wardell a five acre lot near Red Bank, Shrewsbury Township and shortly afterwards erected a house.

At the beginning of the American Revolution, Tilton was imprisoned at the Freehold Gaol for his Tory sympathies. "... on the journey thither, his captors stopped at Colts Neck, where two Loyalists, Aaron and Philip White, were prisoners. The property of Philip, including his shoe and knee buckles, was plundered and he was murdered, while his brother, Aaron, was sent ahead with a party. Philip White's sister requested his body for burial in a coffin which she had taken for the purpose to Freehold, but the request was refused." (A. Jones, The Loyalists in New Jersey p.221)

Tilton secured his release by signing a pact with his captors by which he was required to bear arms against the British. This, however, was not his true intention and in 1776, he fled to the British Lines in New Jersey where he joined the Army. In retaliation, the Rebels seized his home. It was later reported that two cows and a horse had also been confiscated.

On January 15th, 1781, Tilton was commissioned by Sir Henry Clinton as Captain of a company of associated Loyalists; yet the position provided no pay. In 1784, he joined others awaiting passage to British Colony at St. John River. Requesting compensation for his losses, Tilton pleaded that 'he had a wife and large family to support and was reduced to the greatest distress and want.' The sum of 56 pounds was allowed from his claim of 84 pounds.

Immediately upon his arrival at Saint John, Capt. Tilton petitioned for land on Musquash Cove. Here he continued in his trade as ship carpenter and later ran the Musquash Hotel which was to remain in family hands for nearly half a century. On 30 July 1805, he married Elizabeth, the widow of Capt. Thomas Green.

One might surmise that conditions were less than tolerable for soldiers garrisoned at Fort Howe which overlooked the St. John Harbour. Despite the risk of severe punishment, desertions from the fort were quite common.

Local newspapers often carried descriptions of deseters and rewards for their capture. On 17 October 1808, three soldiers of the 101st Regiment met to plan their escape. Patrick McEvoy, the youngest member was reluctant to join, but his comrades Henry Baldwin and James Lennan were persuasive. Their decision to flee to the United States would lead them through the Musquash community where only two weeks before, a local citizen, Mr. Mount, returning late at night from his father-in-law's, was mistakenly shot and killed by a party searching for deserters.

On the fateful night of October 25th, the deserters called upon the house of Ebenezer Scott at Musquash. The following account appeared in 'Acadiensis' in 1906:

"Scott's servant, George Bourdett, on seeing Baldwin with a musket suspected them of being deserters of whom a party had been in pursuit. After pointing out to them the way to Dipper Harbour, Bourdett went over to Clayton Tilton, his master (Mr. Scott) being away from home."

Returning to Scott's residence, Tilton grabbed two muskets, one of which he gave to Bourdette. Accompanied by Tilton's servant, Frederick Shown, they went in quest of the deserters.

"Lennan on seeing them sat down, and soon after Baldwin and McEvoy came on. Baldwin asked Tilton if he knew the way to Dipper Harbour. The latter answered he did, but they should not go there. Lennan then asked him if it was his custom to stop people on the highway. He replied no, but he would not suffer such men to go on. Tilton and Bourdett brought the breeches of their guns to the ground. Lennan thereupon pulled a pistol from his breast and cocked it saying to Baldwin, "Come back. These men will fire upon us." Bourdett then said to Tilton, That man is going to fire; see, he is pulling out his pistol!"

"Tilton then stood up to Lennan and said, "There shall be no firing here.", and Bourdett at the same time said, "We are not going to fire." meaning that their guns were not loaded. Baldwin then came close to Tilton and snapped his gun at him, but missed fire. Tilton then allowed them to pass by."

"For some distance he followed them and said, "You need not think I am afraid of you, for your gun is not loaded." Baldwin returned to within a few paces of him and said, "Sir, I will let you know that I am loaded.", levelled his musket and discharged it, causing a wound from which Tilton died a few hours later."

The young McEvoy was shocked by the experience and was called upon several time before retrieving Tilton's musket.

His unwillingness to act was later to save him from the hangman's noose. The deserters fled into the nearby woods.

'The Times or True Briton', the local paper reported on November 10th: "They were, we learn, apprehended by Capt. John Campbell and two of the Charlotte County Militia on Pain's Island Passamaquoddy Bay)." The deserters were brought before a Magistrate at St. Andrews and ordered to be sent to Saint John for trial. On Sunday night, they were sent on the 'Speedy' Packet and committed to City Gaol.

In keeping with the swift justice of the time, a trial was convened on Tuesday, 17th November at the Circuit Court, Judge Saunders presiding and Ward Chipman prosecuting attorney. The verdict, GUILTY! After conviction, Baldwin and Lennan 'expressed great anxiety that McEvoy should not suffer.' McEvoy was excused for his reluctance in participating in the event. The following Friday the other deserters were sentenced to hang.

On November 24th, the Times or True Briton reported: "Yesterday, Baldwin and Lennan were executed in the presence of a large concourse of people, and the whole of the garrison who were turned out upon the occasion. The spectacle was awful and truly affecting. The criminals were completely and handsomely clad in white, and walked with a firm step, singing Hymns and Psalms from the Prison to the place of Execution, where they spent a short time in Devotion, and appeared fully reconciled to their fate." With the nooses placed the staging was removed. At that instant both ropes broke and both men fell to the ground. It was nearly half an hour later that the execution took place.

Capt. Tilton's widow, Elizabeth was injured in a fall the following year, and was supported by the House of Assembly until her death on 30 November 1827 at 64 years of age.

McFARLANS arrived 1783 at St. Andrews, settled in Parish of St. Patrick, remained there until the 1860 Census put them in the Tobique River area, which they left prior to 1880 to come to BC. Mr. Dahling is interested in acquiring all McFARLAN genealogies of NB, most particularly Charlotte County, as well as finding the origin of John GRAHAM b. 1830 who m. Mary Ann McFARLAN 22/4/1861, Andover and Thomas KENAN b. (?) m. Martha Jane McFARLAN c 1870, probably at WOODSTOCK and had daughters Mary, Flora and perhaps Gladys b NB. Hisline is Robert McFARLAN b. 1799, St. Andrews, Charlotte County son of Walter McFARLAN of 74 Reg't d. after 1860.

Elizabeth Hopkins, P. O. Box 68, Bear River, NS B0S 1B0 writes: A number of years ago, I acquired an old album, which belonged to my father's aunt, Lottie A. NICHOL 1866-1943. The daughter of James (1824-1904) and Maria (Jones 1828-1909) NICHOL. The main purpose of the album seemed to be a place to keep calling cards, of which there are many, with names of persons from Moncton and Sackville area. There is also a few advertisement pictures for Massey-Harris a small calendar for 1892, numerous Christmas and Easter cards and a couple of wedding announcements and birth announcements, the main reason for this letter.

The announcement of the wedding of Leota A. NICHOL to Allison C. RINGER, April 17, 1888 at Brighton, Mass. and a birth announcement of Marion Frances RINGER b. April 13, 1890 at Brighton. The announcement of Cora A. RUSSELL to George A. BRIDGE, Dec. 2, 1883 at Hotel Hudson, Boston, and the announcement of the birth of Charlotte Georgine BRIDGE on July 13, 1888 at Boston.

I thought some of this information might be of value to descendants of these people, I imagine the newsletter makes its way to at least one person either in Brighton or Boston, Mass. I would welcome correspondence with anyone who is interested either in the announcements or calling cards, although I do not wish to part with them. The book is in poor condition, but I might be able to photocopy some of them.
