2- AN ACCOUNT OF THE HEWITT FAMILY AS WRITTEN BY PAUL ANSON HEWITT (1848 - 1930). HEWITT WAS A NATIVE OF SAINT JOHN, NEW BRUNSWICK, CANADA AND WAS AUDITOR OF THE BIG FOUR RAILROAD FROM 1882 to 1910:

"Grandfather William Hewitt, eldest son of the Earl, because he married the family tutor Mary Parker, was disowned and came to America and settled at Machias, Maine. Later, after his death, they settled in Saint John, New Brunswick.

"Father was born on the ocean, the eldest son, on the way over. [William Hewitt, born August 24, 1786, died Saint John, N. B., July 14, 1873]. Grandfather had eight children: William, James, Helen, Catherine, Mary, Ann, George, and Robert. Father married first, Barbara Hunt. She was deaf and dumb. She lived twenty years and then he married second, Francis Wright. She was twenty years old and a widow. She had one child who died soon after birth. They had thirteen children.

"Father's two sisters, Helen and Ann, married two brothers, Joshua and William Mercer. Grandfather was lost at sea on his return to Ireland to become reconciled to his father. My Father was ten years old at the time of his father's death.

"Mother's mother [Catherine Akerly] was born at Ossining, N. Y. Her great-grandmother was a Van Tassel. They lived in New York City and owned all the farms from Trinity Place to the Battery. Her grandmother married James Akerly [should read Obediah Akerly]. Her mother married Solomon Wright. She died at 86 in Saint John, N.B. Grandfather Wright died in 1846 [should read 1849]. Grandmother Hewitt died in 1853 at 94 years of age.

"Grandmother Wright's children were: Susan Austin, Mary Potter, Capt. William Wright, Frances Hewitt, Elizabeth Roop, Margaret Hopley, Catherine Godsoe, Caroline Akerly, Louisa Fairweather. All lived in Saint John, N.B.

"William Wright was a captain in the West Indies Steamship Co. all of his life. The Van Tassels came over with the Dutch Colony, among the first settlers in New York."


EDITORS COMMENTS - Here it is, issue # 2 of the New Brunswick
