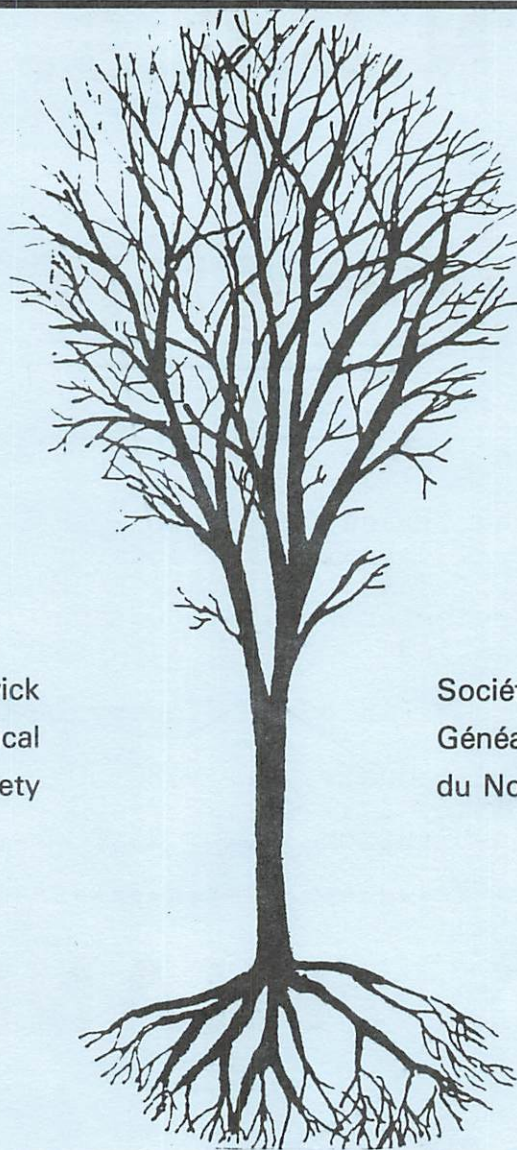

Generations

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GIDEON COREY, HIS DRAKE ANCESTORS

Cynthia L. Bartlett and M. Fred Bartlett^{1,2}

Our investigations on the paternal ancestors of Loyalist and Mayflower descendant, Gideon Corey, were summarized in our previous publication.³ We reviewed his contributions to the early development of New Canaan, New Brunswick; circumstances leading to his exile from his native Rhode Island; and, history of his Corey forefathers living in Rhode Island, Massachusetts, and England. In this article we shall summarize our collection of information on the paternal ancestors of Gideon's mother, Elizabeth Drake Corey, which is summarized in Chart I.

Drake, was the granddaughter of Peregrine White, who was born to William and Susanna White⁵ on the ship Mayflower between 7 and 10 December 1620 while anchored in Provincetown Harbor, Cape Cod.

Early in the twentieth century, Elizabeth Drake Corey's Drake-ancestral line had been of particular interest to a number of New Brunswick residents in the Temperance Vale area. Reasons for this were recently summarized in *The Nackawic Bend*.⁶ Briefly, as the story was relayed in this most interesting book, some of Gideon Corey's descendants believed that they might claim a share of Sir Francis Drake's fortune because of a direct relationship to Thomas Drake, Sir Francis Drake's brother and heir to his wealth. Sir Francis Drake had accumulated a fortune from his seafaring adventures during Queen Elizabeth's reign.⁷ The interesting condition of Sir Francis's will was that his brother, Thomas, would possess the estate for 90 years, his children as long as they lived; and, thereafter, the estate was to be distributed to his children and heirs forever. When Sir Francis's inheritance was released for disbursement by the British crown in the early 20th century, some of Gideon Corey's descendants thought it worth while to send representatives to England in order to make inquiries and bring back records that would support their claim. Unfortunately, the results of their quest appear to have been lost; and no further developments occurred, to our knowledge.

The Corey claim of descent from Sir Francis Drake's brother was based on Elizabeth Drake Corey's father, Captain John Drake (1) of Weymouth, Massachusetts, being the son of John Drake (2) and Hannah Moore of Windsor, Connecticut, and having preceding generations shown in Chart II.

We surmise that this ancestral line for Elizabeth Drake Corey is only correct for her father and mother, Captain John Drake (1, above) and Esther White Joyce. There is no evidence that the John Drake (2, above and Chart II) and Hannah Moore of Windsor, are Elizabeth's grandparents. In addition, John Drake (3) and Prudence Slade are not the parents of this John Drake (II) of Windsor, as depicted in Chart II.⁸

The confusing issue in the Drake genealogies of that time is that two Drake families emigrated to New England in the early to mid-seventeenth century. One family settled in Weymouth, Massachusetts. The other settled in Windsor, Connecticut. Whether these two families are related remains unknown.

Research published recently by the Mayflower Society shows Elizabeth Drake Corey's father as the Captain John Drake (I, above) of Weymouth, Massachusetts, who married Esther White. These parents are shown in both Charts I and II. The Mayflower Society also accepts John Drake and Sarah King of Weymouth, Massachusetts, as Elizabeth Drake's grandfather and grandmother, as depicted in Chart I.⁹ That this John Drake's father and mother were Thomas Drake and Jane Holbrook of Weymouth, displayed in Chart I, has also been published.^{10, 11, 12}

Drake (2) was born in England. He emigrated to New England with his parents, John Drake of Windsor, Connecticut, and Elizabeth Rogers. This John Drake was the son of William Drake of Wiscombe, Devonshire, England, and Phillippa Dennis. William Drake of Wiscombe was the son of Robert Drake of Wiscombe Park, Devonshire, and Elizabeth Prideaux. Robert was a brother of Sir Bernard Drake of Ashe and Mount Drake. Their mother was Amye Grenville, a Plantagenet heir descended from King Edward I.

Sir Francis Drake and his brother, Thomas, are not direct members of these Drake lines, but they are cousins.

The line of descent for Elizabeth Drake, shown in Chart I, was also proposed by Stanley Corey.¹³ He shows John Drake and Esther White of Weymouth, Massachusetts, as Elizabeth's parents, John Drake and Sarah King of Weymouth as her grandparents, and Thomas Drake and Jane Kingman of Weymouth, as great grandparents.

Stanley Corey also claimed that Thomas Drake of Weymouth, Massachusetts, shown in Chart I, was the son of William Drake and Margaret Westofer of Yardbury, Colyton Parish, Devonshire, England.¹⁴ We have not been able to verify this claim.

Undoubtedly Corey based this claim on a publication of 1896 by Lewis Stoughton Drake.¹⁵ A number of subsequent publications did not question Lewis Stoughton Drake's claim.^{16, 17} But, in 1944, Edwin Howard Drake published that this sequence of descent could not be substantiated.¹⁸ He noted that the birth year for Thomas Drake, the son of William Drake and Margaret Westofer of Yardbury, Devonshire, was 1635. This differs by six

John Drake of Ashe and Mount Drake was the eldest son of Sir Bernard Drake of Ashe and Mount Drake -- knighted by Queen Elizabeth in 1585 for his capture of a Spanish galleon off the coast of Newfoundland. The father of Sir Bernard Drake of Ashe and Mount Drake was John Drake of Ashe and Exmouth -- High Sheriff of Devonshire. Sir Bernard Drake's mother was Amye (or Anne) Grenville, a Plantagenet heir descended from King Edward I.

This line of Drakes has a distant connection with the Drakes of Windsor, Connecticut, who were discussed previously. Sir Bernard Drake of Ashe and Mount Drake was a brother of Robert Drake of Wiscombe Park, Devonshire. Robert Drake of Wiscombe Park was a direct ancestor of the previously discussed Drakes of Windsor, Connecticut.

to seven years from the published birth year of 1628/1629 for Thomas Drake of Weymouth, Massachusetts.

It should be mentioned, however, that the age of this Thomas Drake of Weymouth, is recorded only once in official documents (Suffolk, Massachusetts, County Court files), according to Edwin Howard Drake. Consequently, he stressed that unless the difference of ages can be reconciled the Thomas Drake of Weymouth and the Thomas Drake of Yarmbury must be considered to be different people. To our knowledge, no evidence has been found to rectify the age difference of Thomas Drake of Weymouth, Massachusetts, and Thomas Drake of Yarmbury, England.

Thomas Corey and Elizabeth Drake Corey: Gideon Corey's mother was Elizabeth Drake Corey, b 1 March 1724/5 (all dates by old calendar¹⁹). She was the daughter of Captain John Drake and the widowed Esther White Joyce of Weymouth, Massachusetts. Elizabeth married William Corey on 3 April 1743. William died before 6 October 1746 following the birth of two sons, William and Francis. Elizabeth then married his brother, Thomas, on 15 February 1748. By Thomas Corey Elizabeth had four children.

Gideon, his sister Esther Slocum, and his half-brother Francis Corey arrived in New Brunswick with the Loyalist immigrants in 1783. Additional information on this family is included in our previous publication.²⁰

John Drake and Esther White Joyce:²² Esther White married John Joyce of Yarmouth, Massachusetts, on 7 November 1707. He died on 10 January 1714/5 (old calendar). On 25 June 1719, Esther married John Drake of Weymouth,

Massachusetts, son of John and Sarah King Drake. He died in Warwick, Rhode Island, on 21 June 1733, in his 39th year. In the inventory of his estate, John Drake is called a mariner.

Children of John Drake and Esther White Joyce were:

Thomas Drake and Jane Holbrook:^{25, 26, 27} Thomas Drake came to New England about 1652 and shortly after that, settled in Weymouth, Massachusetts. He married Jane Holbrook, daughter of Thomas and Jane Holbrook of Weymouth, Massachusetts. Thomas was registered as a Weymouth land owner in 1663. Thomas was enrolled among the Suffolk troopers and in 1675 - 1676 saw service in King Phillip's war. He purchased a large parcel of land in Freeport. At the time of his death in 1691, his estate at Weymouth, was valued at £237. Jane Holbrook Drake died sometime before 9 March 1681, the date of Thomas Drake's second marriage to Mrs. Millecent Lord Carver, daughter of William Lord.

Samuel King and Experience Phillips:²⁸ Samuel, son of John and Mary King, married Experience, Daughter of Nicholas Phillips and Elizabeth Jenson of Weymouth, Massachusetts, on 17 September 1658. Samuel became a freeman in 1681 and held minor offices in Weymouth. He died on 21 December 1711.

John and Mary King:²⁹ John King of Weymouth, Massachusetts, was married three times. Most of his known children were apparently by his first wife, Mary. He married his second wife, Dorothy Hunt, widow of Enoch Hunt in 1647. She died in 1652, and on 14 October, 1658, John married Abigail Hatch, daughter of John Hewes, and widow of William Hatch, Jr., of Scituate. John King was a mariner and was born in England c 1600 and died in Weymouth, Massachusetts. He had a grant of land in Newton, Massachusetts, in 1636, and was listed as from Lynn, Massachusetts, in 1637.

Nicholas Phillips and Elizabeth Jenson:^{30, 31} Nicholas, son of John Phillips, married Elizabeth, daughter of Richard Jenson and Elizabeth Kipping, in 1631 at Wendover, England. On 4 January 1651, he married Hannah Salter. Nicholas and Elizabeth came to Dedham, Mass., sometime

before 1636 when he was among the men appointed to govern the town from 1636 to 1639. Nicholas gave the town land for its first burial grounds. He was a deacon in Weymouth in 1640. On 13 May 1640 he became a freeman. Nicholas was living in Boston during 1651; and died in September, 1672.

Thomas Holbrook and Jane Kingman:^{32, 33} Thomas, son of William and Edith Holbrook, Wells, Somersetshire, married Jane Kingman in England.³⁴ On 20 March 1635, Nicholas, with his wife and four children left Weymouth for America. At that time Nicholas was thought to be either 34 or 40 years of age.³⁵ It was said that they came from Broadway, Somersetshire. They settled in that part of Weymouth, Mass. known as Old Spain. In 1641, after the earliest preserved Weymouth records began, Thomas Holbrook was chosen a member of selectmen called townsmen. He served as such between 1645 and 1654. In 1643 his property was valued at £186. During his life he became one of Weymouth's largest landholders. His will, dated 31 December, 1668, with codicil dated 31 December 1673, was probated on 24 April 1677. Thomas Holbrook, probably born in 1601, died before 24 April 1677 when his will was probated.^{36, 37}

William and Edith Holbrook:³⁹ William, probably son of Thomas Holbrook and Constans Thayer of Thornbury, Gloucestershire, England, was born c1562. William probably married Edith in June 1612. His will, of 11 December, 1625, probated the following year, is on record in Wells, county seat of Somersetshire. In his will, he names his three sons, Thomas, John and William the younger and his daughter, Basell. Edith was buried in the Church of Saint John the Baptist, Glastonbury, Somersetshire.

Thomas Holbrook and Constans Thayer: Lord claims that this Thomas Holbrook is the above William Holbrook's father because of circumstantial evidence.⁴⁰ Among the reasons given were: Thomas married Constans Thayer in Thornbury, Gloucestershire, on 19 February 1560. Thornbury is a few miles north of Glastonbury, Somersetshire, where succeeding generations of Holbrooks lived. During the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, there were numerous marriages of Holbrooks and Tylyes, including that of Elizabeth Holbrook, daughter of William Holbrook, above. There were also other close alliances with Tylve families.

Probable children of Thomas Holbrook and Constans Thayer:

- William, m. Edith. See above.

This concludes the review of our information on the Drake ancestors of New Brunswick's Gideon Corey.

It is a partial genealogy of William Freeze, who came from Yorkshire to Nova Scotia in 1772, containing about 3500 names. It traces Freeze ancestry back to about 1700. William and four of his sons moved to Penobscis, New Brunswick around 1801. His daughter, Miriam Fenwick and her family moved to Millstream, Kings County, New Brunswick in November 1801. Descendants of these families are to be found in Kings County, across Canada, the United States, and beyond. Many stayed in New Brunswick.

Among descendants of William Freeze are New Brunswick's second Rhodes Scholar, clergymen, professors, farmers, business men, politicians, doctors, senators, lawyers, a shoemaker, and other walks of life.

William Freeze had two daughters. One married a Fenwick and the other a Black. These families are heavily involved. 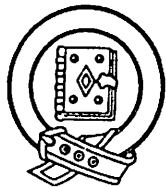

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REPORT ON ENGLISH RESEARCH

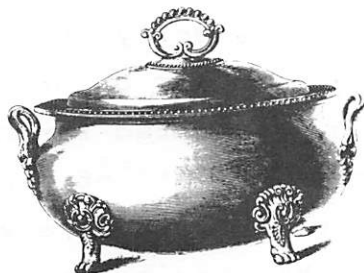

When a preliminary family history of the descendants of John Hill was being written in 1984, I invited interested people who could find ways of improving the book to suggest any ways or provide any information which could achieve this. I certainly did not expect that so many people would respond in so helpful a fashion, and I wish to thank everyone for their help.

I also wish to thank all those people who have helped to plan and carry out the second family reunion of descendants of John and Mary (Coopey) Hill which is scheduled for the Nauwigewauk Community Center on July 23, 1989.

One of the ways in which I felt that the book could be improved was in the area of further development of our knowledge of the English ancestors and relatives of John and Mary (Coopey) Hill and a few people have been especially helpful in assisting with this.

My sister, Mrs. Shirley Howard and her daughter Julia (Howard) Dicks have been very generous in giving of time, effort and expense in hours of research of the Morman International Records. Through their work we now have records of a John and Mary Hill who lived with their family in Hasfield, Gloucestershire, England.

This John and Mary Hill were parents of children baptized or christened as follows:

- * Joseph baptized 13 June, 1806 (1805) (1851)
Mary Ann baptized 6 March, 1808 (1804) Census, Kingston Parish
- * William baptized 21 April, 1811 (1811)
Elizabeth baptized 10 April, 1814 ----
- * John baptized 1 or 9 November, 1817 (1816)
James baptized 20 September, 1819 (died in infancy)

The dates which appear in brackets above are these found on page 22 of "A Preliminary Family History...".

It is important to notice that this information does not prove in itself that these are the same children, born of the same parents as those that our NB. records tell us are our ancestors. But a comparison with our John Hill family show a number of very important common aspects which would lead us to think that indeed these might very well be our ancestral family in England.

These common features are:

1. They all have the very same first or given names (with the exception of James who was said to have died while he was an infant). We also note that the name James does appear in later generations of the "Family tree".
2. Of the four children for whom we had year of birth dates, three of the four agree exactly or are within one year of being the same, (the one year or part of one year's difference * might be accounted for as the time elapsed between date of birth and date of baptism or christening, while the fourth year of birth date was taken from census information which might possibly not be accurate).

3. In addition, Hasfield is located in the same county and general area (Gloucestershire in the Cotswald Hills) as our ancestors were reported to have lived.

Another significant date which is found in the Morman International ^(Genealogical) Index (MGI) which was reported to me by both my sister, Shirley Howard and more recently by Paul Hill is that of 14 August 1804. Following my visit to the County Record Office in March of 1988, Archivist David J.H. Smith and the C.R.O. Research staff were able to verify that indeed a John Hill and a Mary Coopey were married at Churchdown on this date.

Further research revealed that the marriage took place by license rather than banns.

In turn, their license allegation (GDR Q3 86) made on 14 August 1804 gave John Hill's place of residence as Ashelworth, his occupation as "dealer" and his age as "more than 22 years old".

Since this last information indicates that this John Hill lived in Ashelworth, and that he would have been born prior to 1782, the parish register of Ashelworth (P20 IN 1/1) was checked backward from 1782 and the following entry was found: 5 May 1765: John, son of Edward and Elizabeth Hill, was baptized.

If the John Hill above born in 1765 was the same John Hill who lived and died in Kings Co., N.B., Canada he would have been 89 or 90 years old when he died rather than the age of 82 or 83 which we had supposed.

Since at this point we had (and still have) no conclusive evidence that the John Hill identified with the above dates, was our ancestor, I asked Mr. Smith for an opinion on this. His reply was, "From the information found ... it seems quite certain that the man who married Mary Coopey in 1804 was born and baptized in Ashelworth. Although the date of baptism found in the Ashelworth register does not quite coincide with the information which you have from your own sources, I feel that the evidence of the ecclesiastical records which we have found is quite conclusive".

It does appear from the preceeding records and quotation that a good case can be made that Edward and Elizabeth Hill are the parents of our ancestor John Hill, because as Mr. Smith seems to imply, their son John (born in 1765) came from the same place as the man who married Mary Coopey . One might further suggest that the argument against in terms of discrepancy of given birth and baptism dates might be rationalized in some way if one knew all the facts.

On the other hand, Mr. Paul Hill, operating on the assumption that John Hill was born in 1772, told me, (telephone call of June 20, 1989) that his search of records relating to the Hill family found four infants named John Hill who were born in the year 1772. For whatever reason, he mentioned only the one following example "1 November 1772 John, son of William and Ann Hill was baptized in Leigh, Gloucestershire". He seemed inclined to want to think that this John Hill was the same person who was to marry Mary Coopey and become our ancestor. Interestingly, this same record had also been presented by Julia Howard at the 4th planning meeting for the second Hill family reunion. At that point she also made the same suggestion. In the same

telephone conversation Paul Hill (a 5th generation descendant of John and Mary Coopey Hill through their youngest son John) also mentioned that he had discovered a marriage record which he thought might be that of the parents of the John Hill baptized on November 1, 1772. This record indicated that on "16 August, 1770 William Hill married Ann Swanner or Swarner in Toddington, Gloucestershire". He went on to say that Toddington (which I couldn't find on my map) was located near Leigh.

To make the case for William and Ann Hill as parents of "our " John Hill, one might argue that they were natives of the county in which we believe he was born, who gave birth to a son by that name in the year he was believed to have been born. In response to the objection that he was neither born nor baptized in Ashelworth, it might be suggested that even if he wasn't born or baptized there, he would have been..."more than 22 years old", and might have been a "dealer", who by the year 1804, had become a resident of Ashelworth.

On the balance, however, I am now inclined to think that with the information available at the present time, the best case which can be made for the parentage of John Hill is that of Edward and Elizabeth (Price) Hill.

Without going into detail at this time, I will simply mention that, thanks to the diligent research of Mrs K. Haslem, and the research staff at the county record office, records have been found that Edward Hill married Elizabeth Price on January 16, 1762 and that they subsequently had at least the following children:

Edward (christened)	1762
John	" 1765
Ann	" 1767
Elizabeth	" 1771
Mary	" 1774
William	" 1779

This one final set of evidence can be seen as complementary with, and perhaps supporting, the theory that Edward and Elizabeth (Price) Hill were the parents of "our" John Hill. To explain, when we compare the above given names of their children with those of John and Mary (Coopey) Hill's, we see a similarity which could be more than coincidence. The names John, Elizabeth and William, are all names which John and Mary Hill gave to their children which are verified by records in Canada. Similarly, the names of two other children, Mary and Ann, can be seen combined in a fourth name of John and Mary's family, namely, Mary Ann.

Of the only names which are different (aside from James), we might speculate that they could be accounted for as follows: Edward was named after his father, Edward (senior), and (John and Mary's) Joseph, was named after Mary's father and her brother, Joseph Coopey.



In Ottawa on 4 June 1988, His Royal Highness The Prince Edward presented Royal Letters Patent from Her Majesty The Queen to Her Excellency Governor General Jeanne Sauvé, creating The Canadian Heraldic Authority. Canada is the first Commonwealth country outside the United Kingdom to acquire the privilege of granting coats of arms. The establishment of this important new institution will be of great interest to all family historians with Canadian ancestry. A full account of the presentation ceremony appears in the September 1988 issue of Heraldry in Canada, the journal of The Heraldry Society of Canada.

THE 1861 CENSUS OF KINGS COUNTY, NEW BRUNSWICK

Available 01 November 1989, The 1861 Census of Kings County, New Brunswick, includes all surviving population records (the records for Kars and Studholm parishes are missing); all other records are listed in at least summary form. Entries are arranged alphabetically by surname, given name, and age of the head of family. The spellings used for surnames are based upon the most common spelling for each, according to telephone directories for the province of New Brunswick today. Cross-references are arranged by the same system as full entries. Each full entry includes the original spelling of the surname (if different from the standardised form) and the position of the entry within the original census records.

The 1861 Census of Kings County, New Brunswick, is approximately 520pp, in three spiral-bound volumes. Price is \$45.00 postpaid in Canada; all foreign orders please add \$1.50 to cover additional postage. Orders must be received by 31 October 1989, and must include full payment.

More Genealogy Software

After reading Carroll Knox's evaluation of PAF and Family Roots, I could not resist a plug for the genealogy software I am currently using.

Roots III by Commsoft of Mountain View, California is considered by many to be the most versatile piece of genealogy software on the market today.

Roots III's power is practically limited only by the memory of your machine. It will store and process up to 65,535 individuals and an equal number of marriage records and notes. It is capable of 31 children per family, 95 generations and has amply sized record fields (60 characters for names, 48 characters for places etc.). Roots III has 8 different levels of search specifications and prints at least 14 kinds of charts and reports. These include four generation pedigree charts in 80 columns and five generation charts in 132 columns. In addition it will generate 3 kinds of family group sheets, ahnentafels, descendant charts, 2 kinds of heredity statistics, 8 genealogy reports, an individual list, a major footnote list, a marriage list, a calendar, an anniversary list, a relationship report, 3 kinds of summary report, 2 external reference reports, a table of contents. It will also compile and print an index for your book, which incidently is limited to only 10,000 pages. So much for power!

As to versatility, most charts and reports can be customized to your own personal needs and uses. Unlimited biographical material can be added with a text processor while the main program remains in the background. You can even save a lot of typing by using a mouse if you have one.

Various utility packages are available such as:

(1) Histogram, which is a collection of timelines that provide a glimpse of what the world was like during the life of anyone shown on the screen.

(2) Calendar, which a single keystroke accesses, to show Gregorian, Julian, Hebrew or Republican calendars, or more than one side by side.

(3) Revent, an historical database.

(4) Pathway and GEDCOM, a data conversion utility which makes Roots III compatible with the LDS program PAF and provides easy submission of Roots III data to the LDS records in Salt Lake City. GEDCOM is an acronym coined by the LDS church and stands for Genealogical Data Communication. It allows transfer of genealogical information between all types of computers and programs.

(5) Finally, a Tafel Matching System is a computerized Query Database for those who have a modem and allows communications with, and queries to, other users continent wide.

I am very enthusiastic about the program, obviously, and after one year of use I have barely scratched the surface of its capability. It would take a small book to list all its features and details.

Roots III is not cheap, but then quality rarely is. It retails for \$250.00 U.S. and comes with clear detailed documentation. In addition to the usual help screens, there is a user help hot line and a bulletin board system. I receive a newsletter, free updates, and help whenever I need it. The company is very obliging, and has sent me software even before it was paid for. The program comes with a 30 day, money back guarantee.

For those who don't need quite as much power, a previous edition called Roots II is available for \$195.00 U.S.. While the database and features are slightly smaller it is more than adequate for most users.

A colour demo disk is also available with a sample book of charts and forms for \$10.00. Please specify 5 ¹/₄ or 3 ¹/₂ inch disk.

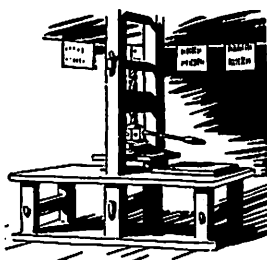
A TIME FOR RE-DEDICATION
