We have a brochure entitled Searching for Your Ancestors on Microfilm just received from the La. State Library which lists microfilm available that may be borrowed through the local library. Cost is \$.15 per copy (min. charge \$1.00). A copy was also placed in box marked "Misc.-How to.." on the periodical shelf in the genealogy section at the main branch library. Some of the reels available include Military and Pension Records of La. for Confederate Veterans, War of 1812; Brand Books for Opelousas & Attakapas 1760-1888; Notre-Dame Du Fort De Conde De La Mobile, 1704-1764; St. Martinville, 1756-1794; St. Gabriel, 1773-1859; Marriage and succession records from many parishes; some early newspapers...

Father Donald Hebert has donated to the Society the new complete set of Bona Arsenault's Histoire Et Genealogie Des Acadiens, for which we are most grateful. The following is condensed from HISTORY OF SABINE PARISH, by John G. Belisle, published in 1912.

Spain had been much displeased because of the sale of Louisiana to the United States. The western frontier of Louisiana was the scene of Spanish hostility to the U. S. The boundary between French La. and Spain's Mexican empire had never been fixed, and at the time of Jefferson's purchase Spain claimed all of Texas as well as a strip of land in La. lying between the Sabine River and the Arroyo Hondo, a tributary of Red River, seven miles west of Natchitoches, extending north along Red River and south, on an imaginary line to the Gulf.

No agreement was reached on the western boundary until 1820 when the U. S. acquired the Florida territory and by the same treaty gave to Spain all claim to Texas; the Sabine River was designated as the boundary. In 1806 Gen. Wilkinson and the Spanish General agreed this should be neutral territory. For fourteen years this section had no government of any kind, thus it became the rendezvous for outlaws from the U. S., Mexico and other parts of the world. It was the home of robbers, murderers, and plotters against the government. The whole of SABINE PARISH was included in this "NO MAN'S LAND". There were two avenues of travel through Sabine Parish, the road from Natchitoches to San Antonio, passing through Ft. Jessup and the present town of Many, and the highway known as Nolan's Trace, blazed by Phillip Nolan, which extended between Alexandria and Texas. Fallen Springs, four miles south of Many was a popular camping ground, and in this vicinity many robberies and murders are said to have taken place.

Several years before the boundary between La. and Texas was settled, immigrants from the old states had settled in West La. and located in the Neutral Strip within the present boundary of Sabine Parish. They represented various races of Northern Europe, the German, Irish, Scotch, Dutch, and Anglo Saxon. They sought the unoccupied lands where they could build their homes. A large number of the first immigrants to Sabine Parish settled on what was known as Rio Hondo lands. 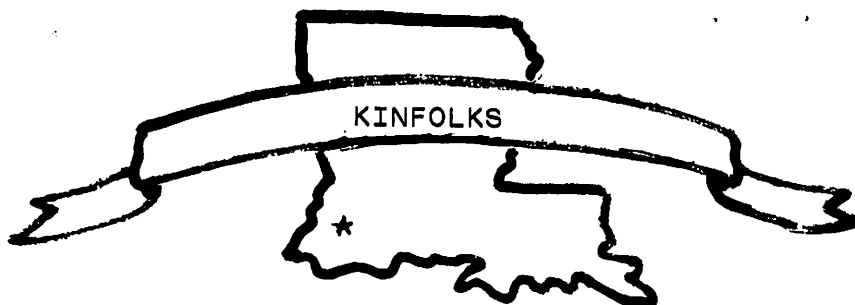

LANDRY PARISH AREA", which was published in the ATTAKAPAS GAZETTE, Vol. XIII, No. 3 (Fall 1978). In addition to the TATE family, background information is given on the families of FONTENOT, MAURICE (OLIVIER), IVY, HAY, and BUNDICK.

A list of family associations and their periodicals published in the U. S. has been compiled by Merle Ganier, 2108 Grace St., Fort Worth, Texas 76111. This directory is filed under "Miscellaneous" in the Society files at the Downtown Branch Library. Merle also publishes "THE KNIGHT LETTER" which is also in our files.

One of our exchange bulletins, "THE COLORADO GENEALOGIST" informs us that "...the practice of granting public lands to soldiers as bounties or as a reward for service was adopted during the colonial period and continued until 1855. 95 million acres of U. S. land was given for military bounties and private claims. There are 450,000 separately filed bounty-land claim folders in the National Archives - maybe the very records you need to unlock your genealogical problems." A detailed and informative article entitled "U. S. Military Reserves 1778 - 1819" is published in Vol. 40, 1979 and on file in the Genealogical Room of the Downtown Branch, Calcasieu Parish Library.

Did you know that if you trace your family back 10 generations you will have 1024 ancestors? Your roots are entwined with those of many, many families.

FIRST FAMILIES OF SOUTHWEST LOUISIANA

(This is the first of a series of articles which we hope to continue on the earliest settlers of Southwest La. The following article was contributed by Betty Rosteet.)

LEBLEU FAMILY

The first white settler in the area now known as Southwest Louisiana was Bartholome (Barthlemey) LeBleu. He was the son of Marie Gentil of the Illinois Country and Louis LeBleu of New Orleans.

He wed Marie Josephe de la Mirande at the Opelousas Post 16 October 1769. Marie Josephe, the daughter of Hypolite Chauvin de la Freniere and Joseph de la Mirande, was born in the Illinois Country about 1750. On the maternal side, Marie Josephe de la Mirande was descended from Nicolas Chauvin de la Freniere, who had a part in the founding of Biloxi and New Orleans.

The Chauvin family can be traced to Rene Chauvin and his wife Catherine Avard, both of whom immigrated from Anjou, France to Montreal, Canada. Three sons of the Chauvin family adopted the appellations of DeLery, Beaulieu, and de la Freniere.

Marie Josephe de la Mirande LeBleu was the mother of six children: Hypolite, Catherine, Arsene, Jean Baptiste, Osite, and Martin.

Hypolite was baptized 11 October 1780 at the age of 2 months. She married Sebastien Benoit, widower, 20 August 1800.

Catherine was born 12 January 1787 and was baptized 18 May 1787. On 9 August 1802 she married Carlos Anselme Sallier, as his second wife. She died 3 December 1860.

Arsene was baptized 30 October 1789. He had three wives, Felicite Reon, Martha (Sarah) Andrus, and Eliza Milhomme, whom he married 17 October 1850 in California.

Jean Baptiste was baptized 18 July 1790. On 18 May 1813 he wed Margaret LeJeune.

Osite was born 24 March 1792 and was baptized 1 March 1794.

Martin was born 5 October 1793 and was baptized 1 March 1794. He married Eloise Reon on 9 October 1820.

In 1776 Barthlemey LeBleu was not among the members of the Louisiana militia, being at the time "too old or too infirm" to serve.

Marie Josephe de la Mirande LeBleu died 12 December 1808.

Their descendants are numerous and are to be found in many families having Southwest Louisiana roots.
