



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

The Priests of the Plague Summer

Irish immigrants felled by typhus remembered at Grosse Ile



If anyone has a query as a result of this article, Mr. Thompson might be able to assist with some addresses in Québec that hold the records of the orphans and their adoptive families as he has a list of orphans adopted by French families in that terrible summer.]

The entry of Irish dead in the church register strikes a note of sorrow and monumental loss:

"The 16th of June, eighteen forty seven, I the undersigned priest have buried in the cemetery of this place, the bodies of Patrick Slattery, aged five months; of Judith Darcy, aged five years; of John Booth, aged forty years; and of forty-four others unknown coming from different hospitals of this place ...

P. Rose, priest."

"This place" is Grosse Ile, a narrow pine-clad island in the St. Lawrence River 30 miles down river from Québec City. In spring, wildflowers carpet the meadows, and in autumn, migrating ducks and birds rest in the shallow bays.



The rolling trenches of the common graves are dotted with simple white crosses. There were 5,300 reported deaths from typhoid during the summer of 1847, although some historians believe as many as 12,000 may have died.

The hospitals where Father Rose worked had served adequately since 1832 as receiving quarantine stations for arriving Irish immigrants. But in that horrible summer of 1847 it turned to a place of calamity and death for thousands of impoverished families seeking a better life in North America.

Many Catholic priest from Québec City and nearby parishes responded readily to the suffering. They risked their lives to put commitment to their faith into action. In 1847, authorities in US and Canadian ports braced for a flood of tenant farmers driven from their land by foreclosures, hunger, and failed crops.

On Grosse Ile, Dr. George Douglas, the medical officer, supervised the repair of hospital sheds damaged by winter storms. He laid in food and medical supplies. Colleagues in New York wired him to expect unprecedented numbers of immigrants from the embarkation ports - Cork, Dublin, Sligo, and Liverpool.

No one warned Douglas of a dreaded ships'

passenger — typhus.

On May 17, shortly after winter ice left the St. Lawrence, the ship *Syria* anchored off Grosse Ile. Of her 241 Irish passengers 84 were sick. Nine had died on the sea passage. Another 40 were taken to the hospital, where they died within a few days.



Sensing imminent disaster, Douglas sent urgent messages for aid to the immigration agent in Québec City. But already he was too late. Within four days, eight more ships arrived. Their crews off loaded 430 feverish passengers.

Now Douglas was writing his superiors in Québec: "I have not a bed to lay them on or a

place to put them in."

Before month's end, 40 ships holding 15,000 passengers stretched in a two-mile line down the river. All held dead or sick agonizing with delirium, thirst, headache or diarrhea. The hospital sheds filled to overflowing. Medical personnel spread families of sick on the beaches, under shady oak trees, inside

sprawling canvas tents. The little wooden Church of St. Luke echoed with sickly groans and pleas for water.

The crushing June heat intensified the suffering. Since many of the ships' crewmen were ill, soldiers on the island had to assist in unloading passengers. One report tells of bodies being winched out of a hold, the golden hair of a young girl moving in the breeze.

Soon the priests were recording 50 deaths daily on average. Douglas himself became ill and had to be restrained from his duties. Father O'Reilly, an assisting priest, noted: "It was a wonder to us all that he could withstand the horrible fatigues he had to undergo."

To aid the doctors in their Herculean task, both Catholic and Protestant clergy hurried to Grosse Ile from Québec City.

Father Bernard McGauran of Nôtre Dame de Québec brought the first group of priest, teaching professors from the seminary. Though typhus felled Father McGauran, he recovered and returned later in the season, remaining until the station closed in late autumn.

His brothers moved uncomplaining among the fetid sheds, fetching barley water and tea for the sick, or rowing out to the ships to administer last rites.

Because of their numbers these determined clergymen were able to rotate their periods of service and recuperate off the island. Still, four priests and two other clergymen fell victim to the plague.

Willingly the priests assumed care for the flood of orphans. The hospital steward made careful note of unclaimed funds from the dead, which helped later to house and feed the children.

One treasure for historians and genealogists that survives this tragedy is the 1847-48 register of these children kept by the Québec City Charitable Society. These careful records include a child's name, date of arrival, parents' name, parish, county, vessel, and adoptive family if known.

Reading its pages pulls at the heart.

Consider the agony of Ellen, Michael, Mary and Richard Bible, age 10, 12, 17 and 6 respectively. Parents unknown, parish unknown, county unknown, vessel unknown. "Deceased Aug. 6 and 9."

Or rejoice with James, John and Margaret Mahon, age 8, 12 and 14; father John, mother Ellen; of Riseisver Parish, County Leitrim; off the ship *Argo*. "Left Oct. 28 Toronto for their father John."

Families along the St. Lawrence opened their homes and hearts to these orphans. All those having no family or refuge elsewhere were soon adopted by French-Canadian


Day or half-day tours can be arranged with *Corporation pour la mise en valeur de Grosse Ile* at 6 rue Bernatchez, Montmagny, Québec G5V 1H2 (418) 248-4832.

Transportation to the island is by a new 75-passenger boat. English speaking guides-interpreters accompany each group.

Full-day tours run Saturday and Wednesday. Inspection of the entire island, including the Celtic cross, the graveyards, fever sheds, and Cholera Bay costs \$65 (Canadian) and includes brunch and a four-course dinner at the end of the tour.

Half-day tours run Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Visitors see the western half of the island, graveyards, Cholera Bay and Celtic cross. Cost is \$45 (Canadian) and includes brunch.

Tours run from June 1st through October1st.

families. One mercy was that the children should keep their Irish surname so that their heritage would endure with them.


As the cooler weather of autumn approached, the suffering diminished. Recuperatives moved upriver in steam barges to Kingston, Toronto, Niagara Falls and into distant US cities. Many, like John Ford from County Cork, journeyed alone, having buried a spouse at Grosse Ile. He moved to Detroit, where later his grandson Henry Ford created a new industry. In their own fashion all these survivors soon gave their energy and labor to shaping a new continent.

As time passed and grieving healed the terror, many Irish planned for a suitable monument to remember the victims and to sanctify their burial ground.

Douglas had already raised a small stone pillar to commemorate the medical personnel and Irish dead in that summer of sorrow. His monument records their number at 5,300. But modern historians tend toward 12,000, citing government cover-up and the high number of bodies dumped overboard or disappeared in the woods and river.

In 1898 the Québec chapter of the Ancient Order of Hibernians lobbied the Canadian Department of Agriculture to raise on Grosse Ile a worthy memorial. Soon that permission was granted.

By August 1909, a granite Celtic cross stood ready for dedication on Telegraph Hill on the western end of the island. The ceremony was dignified and solemn. More than 9,000 Irish celebrants from the United States and Canada gathered in the large meadow of trench graves that undulate now — as then — in soft rows colored with daises, goldenrod, and whitewashed crosses.

Redemptorist Father John Haney, pastor of St. Patrick's Parish, Québec, celebrated the requiem Mass. He reminded his listeners of the great suffering here, of sacrifice, endurance and love.

Father Haney urged them to take hope from the inscription on the monument, written in Gaelic and English:

Sacred to the memory
of thousands of Irish
emigrants who, to preserve
the Faith, suffered hunger
and exile in 1847-48,
and stricken with fever,
ended here their sorrowful
pilgrimage.

The victim's courage and heroism, and the strength of their survivors, is the greatest memorial of all.

The Old Catholic Cemetery

Marquette, Michigan

The old Catholic Cemetery (Pioneer Road & County Road 553) will be moved. The Diocese of Marquette (Michigan) printed the names and dates of burials recorded there in the local newspaper. A good many of them are French-Canadians who were attracted to this area by the mines, railroads, and lumber industry. This was a legal advertisement dated July 7, 1992 and published July 27, 1992.

The last paragraph read as follows:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 24th day of August 1992, 3:00p.m., a hearing will be held in the Marquette County Circuit Court before the Honorable Edward A Quinnell, Circuit Judge, upon a Petition of the Diocese of Marquette seeking an order of Disinterment from the grounds known as the Old Catholic Cemetery, through vandalism and other causes, no longer provides a place of dignified repose. The Diocese of Marquette proposes to sell the parcel to the Knights of Columbus and proposes to establish an appropriate memorial at the Holy Cross Cemetery for those persons buried in the Old Catholic Cemetery. Consent is sought by the Diocese of Marquette pursuant to the statue provided to obtain an Order of Disinterment to relocate any final resting places as may be needed ...



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
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ANDERSONVILLE CEMETERY

TOWN OF GLOVER, ORLEANS COUNTY, VERMONT

Andersonville Cemetery is in a rather remote location of the Town of Glover, quite near the Glover/Albany town line. There are no doubt a myriad of different ways to get to this location, but the simplest would seem to be turning onto Roaring Brook Road in the town of Barton and proceeding past the Orleans County Fairgrounds just 2.6 miles on the paved road to West Glover. Turn right and stay on the paved road exactly 2 miles to where it becomes a gravel road. Continuing on for another 4.8 miles taking



no turns will deliver you right to the cemetery, which is located on the right hand side of the road. Andersonville is approximately 175 feet across by 150feet deep and is fronted with an ornate white iron fence. The three remaining sides are a combination of barbed wire, scrub trees and accumulated field rock. The peaceful serenity of this place is broken only by the many swallows that inhabit the numerous birdhouses placed around the fence line, and the occasional hum of farm equipment operating off in the distance.

Standing in the center of the cemetery and looking to the west, visitors are treated to a panoramic view of forested hillsides and well carved out farm land with what appears to be Craftsbury Common partly exposed on one hillside. This cemetery seems well cared for but still has a number of stones that have been broken over the years and left unattended.

The Loiselle Marriage Index

With Notes on Other Indexes

a letter from Edna Finn #9C

In the Spring 1992 issue of Lifelines, mention was made by our President, Marie Gennett, that our society had recently purchased the Loiselle Marriage Index on *microfiche* for use by our members.

This index was compiled by Father Antoine Loiselle of the Parish of Nôtre Dame de Grace in Montréal. Fr. Loiselle passed away in 1986 and left this rich legacy of information for use by researchers.

Members should be aware that our society published the film numbers for surnames, with guidelines for using the *microfilm* format, as the index originally appeared. This appears in the Fall 1988 issue of *Lifelines*.

While those film numbers may not coincide with the fiche format, the guidelines for using the information contained in the Loiselle Marriage Index are the same, and are re-printed here to especially benefit our newer members who may not have the Fall 1988 issue at their disposal. These guidelines are a definite asset to use in viewing either format.

- 1. The Loiselle index is an index to the marriage records in Québec; Madawska County, New Brunswick; and Manchester, Hillsboro, New Hampshire, 1642-1963.
- 2. It is an index in one alphabet to brides and grooms.
- 3. Each index entry gives the name of the bride and the groom, the date and parish of the marriage. If the bride or the groom is not widowed the entry will also record the names of his or her parents.
- 4. If either the bride or the groom is widowed the record of the marriage will indicate the name of the previous spouse. To find the names of the parents of a widow(er) it is necessary to find the index entry for the first marriage.
- 5. If either parent of the bride or groom is deceased this is indicated on the index.
- 6. If the parents of either spouse were married in a parish other than the one in which their child is married the index will indicate the parish of the parents' marriage.
- 7. Most of the entries are typewritten.
- 8. A list of abbreviations used for first names and localities, and a list of all the parishes which were indexed (with beginning and ending date), are filmed at the beginning of each reel of the index.
- 9. The alphabetical order of the cards is only approximate. The Parishes covered are listed at the beginning of each film.

For those of our members who find this method of researching rewarding, there is also the Rivest Marriage Index, as well as the Fabien Index.

Rivest Marriage Index

The Rivest index covers the marriage records of the parishes located in the notarial districts of Joliette, St Jerome, Mont-Laurien, and Sorel, Québec from the 17th century to 1972.

Fabien Index

The Fabien index is a collection of seventy 16mm films containing 270,000 entries of marriages from 1857-1974. It covers the parishes north and south of the Ottawa River in Québec, as well as Ontario, Eastern and Northern Ontario, Pontiac County, the Island of Montréal, the Huntington and Chateauguay regions of Québec, and a few others.

This index is a complement to the Loiselle Index and they do overlap in a few areas. There are also a few marriage contracts and newspaper clippings.

Please note that the National Archives of Canada, 395 Wellington Street, Ottawa, P.O. Canada K1A 0N3, has the Fabien index on 16mm film which may be borrowed from them through your library if it subscribes to their services through inter-library loan. They do not have the Loiselle or Rivest marriage indexes on microfilm. These are, however, available through the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints at their libraries throughout the country.

The Smallman Collection

Many researchers are familiar with Mary Smallman, and her late husband, C. Walter Smallman. Walt was Franklin County Historian for many years while a resident of that county, and Mary held the same post in St Lawrence County for many years.

They also conducted a genealogical research enterprise called *Search and research* from their home in Hermon, New York. Their area of expertise was primarily confined to St Lawrence and Franklin Counties.

A few years ago, following the death of her husband in 1985, Mary became less involved in doing research and more recently, donated much of their material to a few select archives.

Genealogists will be interested to know that she placed the family file cards, correspondence, and other material with the Later Day Saints Library in Potsdam, NY, where they are available to the public. It is located at 21 Castle Drive and is open on Wednesday evenings from 7-9 p.m. (phone: 315-265-6228).

The Wead Library was the recipient of material on subjects dealing primarily with Franklin County, i.e. prohibition, rum running, etc. Wead Library was also instrumental in purchasing from Mary, seven reels of microfilm of the newspaper Facts and Fallacies, published in Brushton (formerly Brush's Mills) area of Franklin County. These newspapers date from 11 May 1899 to 11 November 1954 and the films do not circulate. The Wead Library is located at 64 Elm Street in Malone, NY. Hours - September through June from noon to 5, and 6-9 p.m., Monday through Friday. Also, on Saturday from noon to 5 p.m. During July and August they are open from noon to 6 from Monday through Thursday, and on Friday from 10 to 4, and 6-9 p.m. (Phone: 518-483-5251).

Finally, Paul Smith's College Library in Paul Smith's, NY received miscellaneous Adirondack material, maps, books, etc. The books are integrated with the stacked books. The Librarian will be glad to locate other items, upon request. (Phone: 518-327-6313)

Joachim Thibert & Marie Guillimin, of St-Jean, Bourgogne, France, did not come to New France (Canada); their son Jean-Marie Thibert dit Marion came in the early 1740s. Jean-Marie Thibert was married 17 Feb. 1744 at St-Michel de Yamaska, Yamaska County, PQ. At least two of their children settled at Chateauguay, Chateauguay, Co., PQ. They were Pierre, who first married M-Louise Bonneau 1780 Chateauguay, PQ at St-Joachim de Chateauguay, and also married M-Francoise Poissan 1805 at the same parish.

Regarding his brother Joachim, I have not yet found his marriage, but all his children—as well as Pierres' children—were married at St-Joachim de Chateauguay. The family branches out to Beauharnois and others in the area. The *dit* or called name of Marion does not seem to extend down past the first generation of Jean-Marie Thibert. Much research still needs to be done as it appears the family branches off to Northern New York.

This family would have originally lived in New Jersey, and most likely had a Quaker background. At some point, about 1805, the whole family, including the adult sons would have removed to western New York state, settling in Ontario County, New York, which then included all of present day Ontario County, and parts of (present day) Yates, Livingston, Monroe, and Wayne Counties.

Family tradition has indicated that there was a Willets family living in the United States with the following children:

- 1. David m. Catherine Drake, in 1810 in Ontario County, New York. After 1811 he removed to near Ancaster, Canada; see X.1.1.
- 2. John, b 1773, New Jersey, m abt 1795, wife unknown, but of Orleans County, New York, he d after 1850 in New York. (This line will be followed at a later date.)
- 3. Mary, b abt 1784 m "Deacon" John Drake, b 23 October 1782 (New Jersey?), removed to Jerseyville, Canada, d 29 November 1853 in Wentworth County, Ontario and buried in Vansickle Cemetery.
- 4. Gideon, b abt 1787, m "out of" Quaker Meeting before 23 March 1810. Gideon Willets acknowldged his error, and was reaccepted on 27 September 1810. Later, about 1815, Gideon Willits and family removed to Ancaster, Canada. See 7X.1.40.

Notes on the spelling of the Willits surname

This family in the early part of the 1800s has switched from the spelling of Willits to Willits, Willets, Willets, and Willet, Wilett, and other variations. As often as possible, within this document, the exact spelling of the surname is indicated as it appears in comtemporary records.

David Willits was born about 1765, probably in New Jersey. David Willet (sic) married at Harwick, Sussex County, New Jersey, on 17 November 1799, Catherine Drake, b 12 June 1779, the daughter of Joseph Drake, Jr and Sarah Carson (they were married 10 March 1775).

On other transcripts or records of this marriage, David Willet's surname is shown variously as Willitt and Willits. David Willits was originally a Quaker; however, it is not known if he practiced this faith for his whole life, or if it was passed on to his children.
