LETTER FROM THE EDITOR

Many of you may be aware of, or have read about, the "missing heir" schemes currently sweeping the country. But if I can stop one of you from lining the pockets of these people, then it is worth a few lines in this Letter.

The Wisconsin Attorney General recently issued a warning regarding the "heir chasers". Although it is not necessarily an illegal operation, the public should be aware of the nature of the business. Persons (generally with a common surname) will receive a letter stating they may possibly have a claim to an estate or property for which all heirs have not been found. They offer to supply copies of documents for a fee, which ranges from \$9 to \$20. The customer then receives photocopies of death and probate records (which prove nothing) of a specific estate. Rarely ever is a claimant found by this method. These are public records that may be obtained much cheaper other ways.

There are legitimate "missing-heir" searchers who are Certified Genealogists, and if you suspect you may have a claim to an estate, contact one of them or an attorney. Be suspicious of any unsolicited offer!

In the same vein, I recently read about a retired military man who received an unsolicited offer to supply his coat of arms. His name usually was written as: Col. John SMITH (Ret). This letter offered the information that the surname RET was an uncommon one, but there were several hundreds in the United States. "It probably Originated from....." That gives you an idea of the authenticity of the Coat of Arms. Quite a few years ago a family member of my husband, and also someone from my family, spent the \$2 to see what would be presented as our "coat". Shortly thereafter, I had the opportunity to see a rare book, printed in Germany in the 1800s with all of the German Heraldry. I photocopied the coats assigned to both surnames and later compared them with the \$2 "coat"--there was no resemblance to either one.

In a happier vein, I would like to comment about another kind of "unsolicited mail". I mean the lovely letter you receive from someone who has taken the time to answer your query. Please remember to answer the letter and thank the person, even if it doesn't fit in your line.

Many subscribers jotted a note on their renewal slip and I really appreciated your comments--the lift to the ego was tremendous. Besides lifting my ego, there were comments such as: "Elmer Courteau is the greatest!"; "Mrs. DeMarce certainly is knowledgeable about the area of Canada that I am searching"; "Paul Lareau sent me pages of material on my line"....etc. Thank you people, as well as all the others who have contributed material for publication and have taken the time to answer someone's query. SOME EARLY FRENCH-CANADIAN FAMILIES

It is very difficult to pinpoint the arrival in America of the majority of French-Canadian families since few ship records are available.

Generally, the first notice of an ancestor's appearance in North America will be found in a land transaction, his marriage certificate, or the formal contract of marriage covering the dowry terms.

In the earliest ancestor's marriage record will generally appear the date of his baptism in France, the place, and the names of his parents, but often there is a gap of many years between this baptismal date in France and his sudden appearance in French Canada.

Research in France has uncovered some work contracts of these First Families of Canada, and while family historians still cannot be certain of an exact date, it would be fairly certain that these heads of families arrived in the early months of their engagements.

Mme. Pierre Montagne in her work, "Tourouvre et les Juchereau", a story of immigrants from the Province of Perche, France, to Canada, has unearthed 41 of these contracts. The book was published in 1965 by the Societe Canadienne de Genealogie (Quebec).

The contracts include those of Jean MERY, Mathurin PROVOST, Francois MABILLE, Jacques LE ROY, Jacques POUPAR, Jean MALENFANT, Louis GUIMONT, Rene DUTEILL, Pierre PIAU, Rene VISAGE, Daniel TREMOND, Julien MERCIER, Pierre ALOGNON, Rene VIGNERON, Philibert CHAUDON, Pierre LANDE, Jacques LOISEAU, Pierre de MONCHEVREUL, Jean MERCIER, Martin HUAN, Pierre TREMBLAY, Raoullin FRONDIERE, Jean CHEMIN, Pierre PITOT, Jehan TREHARD, Martin COSNARD, Pierre ENJOUIS, Louis POTIER, Francois DU TARTRE, Gervaise RIBAUT, Nicolas RIVARD, Marin CHAUVIN, Jean DUBOIS, Jacques LEVEAU, Jean CRESTE, Nicolas HUBLIN, Pierre MAHEUX, Jacques NOURY, Nicolas ROUSSIN, Francoise ROUSSIN, and Francoise LEHOUX.

This book also contains details of the origins of the JUCHEREAU family and the families of Henry PINGUET, Guillaume PELLETIER and his wife Michelle MABILLE; Mathurin, Jean and Pierre GAGNON, Charles GUILLEBOURG, Aubin LAMBERT, Michel CHASTEL, Pierre COCHEREAU, Robert GIGUERE, Jean ROUSSIN, Michel CHASTEL, Francois PROVOST, Antoine LE FORT, and Robert GIFFARD.

Historians who can trace an ancestress to a fille à marier or fille de roi can be fairly certain that her marriage date in Canada is within a year or two of her arrival. These women were recruited in France as prospective brides of men already in Canada. The filles des roi (daughters of the king) were so-called because they received a special dowry from the royal purse.

While not exact, census records may provide the earliest dates of a family's arrival for many historians. This is especially true of any with ancestors among the Acadians.

Among the earliest of these census records is a list of immigrants who left France for Acadia April 1, 1636. The list, taken from LeBlanc's "The Acadian Miracle" (Evangeline, Lafayette, La., 1966), includes: Nicollas LE CREUX and wife; her sisters Anne and Jehanne MORIN and brothers Claude and Jehan MORIN; their cousin, Jacqueline de GLAINEE; Jehanne BILLARD, Jehan CHALUMEAU and wife; George MIGOT and wife; Jehan HYECHTIER and wife; Simon MERLIN and wife; Jehan PERICAUDS and wife; Jehan GUIOT and wife; Nicollas BAGOLLE and wife; Isaac PESSELIN; Hilaire BICAU and wife; Jehan DONNON, Roch ROCHE, Martin LEDOUX, Tibault de TOUCHES and wife with three children; Pierre MARTIN, wife and child, Jehan MANGONNEAU, wife and child, the Widow PERIGAUULT and sons Michel and Julien, Adrien BENAISTON, Pierre le MOINNE,

Noel TRANCHANT, Guillaume TRAHAN, wife, two children and valet, Louis DENIAU, Telyre TATTE, Daniel CHICHERAU, Jehan DANJOU, Michale GALLANT, Jehan VACHE, Louis BLANCHARD, Pierre PAQUIS, Aime GUIOT, Andre BACONNEAU, Francois GUION, Gille DIONNE, Jouanis DESTIQUY, Jehan de BOURGONORE, Jouanis de HAUSQUIN, Jehan de LAFAYE, Bernard BUGUARE, Jouanis LEVERT, Bernard TEGRANOUS, Abraham DOISTICH, Saint MARTIN dit GASCON, Rhene ARQUANGE, Jehan SANDRE and wife, Pierre GABORY, Jehan PROVOST, Francois BAUDRY, and Pierre BRAULT.

While unable to give exact dates, LeBlanc believes the following families arrived in Acadia before 1650: AUCOIN, BOUR (BOURG/BOURQUE), BABIN, BELLIVEAU, BERTRAND, CORMIER, DUGAST, DUPUIS, GAUDET, GIROIRE, GAUTROT, JOFFRIAN, HEBERT, LANDRY, LE BLANC, POIRIER, ROBICHAU, SAVOIE, and THIBODAU.

While there were many earlier arrivals, the title of First Settlers of New France is usually given to Louis HEBERT and his wife Marie ROLLET who arrived in 1617. A monument in their honor and in honor of other first settlers stands in the Place de l'Hotel de Ville in Quebec. Many among this list of pioneers dating from Louis HEBERT (1617) to DE CHAVIGNY (1636) were married twice, even three times. But the French colony was so small that the arrival of some 100 colonists (the exact number is generally disputed) in 1653 aboard the ship St. Nicolas of Nantes, is still celebrated as the Great Recruitment.

French-Canadians who can trace their ancestors to passengers aboard the St. Nicolas or a later, smaller group that arrived aboard the St. Andre in 1659 also are among the few French-Canadians who can exactly date the arrival of their ancestors in Quebec.

A complete list of the passengers on the St. Nicolas is printed in Auger's "La Grande Recrue de 1653" published in 1955 at Montreal by the Societe Genealogique Canadienne-Francaise. Some died en route. Many returned to France. Some were killed by Indians or died early deaths in Canada. CHALUT - SHALLOW descendants of USA and Canada, 1641-1974. This history of the CHALUT family from France to Canada to USA is well-written, easy to follow, and interesting to read. Mrs. Vint has added maps, diagrams, ancestral charts and photographs as well as many stories of these early people. I found myself reading the anecdotes of their lives with as much interest as if they were my own family, and I'm anxious to try Grandmother Julienne's Soupe aux pois Canadienne (Canadian Pea Soup). Closely allied surnames are MENARD, DE TREPAGNY/TREPANIER, LOISEL, JARRET dit BEAUREGARD, among many others. All surnames are indexed with a sub-index of given names. The book is well-bound with an attractive cover and may be ordered from the author for \$6.

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Shortly after making the statement (in print) that I had not received a book I had ordered, it arrived! I don't think my remark had anything to do with it, but I was happy to receive "Smith's Canadian Gazetteer". Originally published in 1846 this was the first gazetteer of the Province of Ontario. Brief descriptions are given of the towns and there are distance tables, post offices, stage and steamboat fares, principal hotels and taverns, and much information regarding the general type of life. Soil, climate, and average value of land of each locality and a "mass of other desirable and useful information for the man of business, traveler, or emigrant". A fold-out map of Canada West has been most helpful to me as general reference. The order blank enclosed with the book lists it for \$3.95 for paper cover, however I sent a check for \$5 and assume the balance was used for mailing costs.
