

## LETTER FROM THE EDITOR

I would like to apologize for the poor quality of printing in this issue. Things should have been great, with my new memeo and a brand new typewriter which has an element instead of keys, and a correction feature (which I use a lot). But there have been some big problems. When I tried it out it cut a beautiful stencil. Several weeks later when I purchased it, the quality of stencil cutting dropped to 0. Even though I tried three different brands and qualities of stencils, nothing seemed to be consistent. Hopefully, by the May issue the problems will be solved, at least with the typewriter. It seems some piece of equipment manages to give a problem with each issue.

The index to Volume 5 is being sent with this bulk mailing to those of you who had ordered in advance. However, there were only about 90 orders! There is a tremendous amount of work involved in preparing an index, and it seems ridiculous to go to all that work and expense for so few orders. Until I have a computer, there won't be an index printed again, although at that time I will try to catch up with prior volumes. Or, is there a reader with a computer that would be willing to do the index for me? I am willing to print it, just unwilling to do the labor. It took over two weeks of 8 hour days, doing nothing else, just to put the names on the index cards.

Those of you who have research interest in the Provinces of Newfoundland and Prince Edward Island must be aware that there doesn't seem to be a lot of resource material easily available. It appears the basic research tools are the Union List of Manuscripts, the Preliminary Inventory of Manuscripts, and correspondance with the Heritage Foundation (of P.E.I.) and the Provincial Archives of each. If any of you have some additional suggestions, send them to me and I'd be happy to pass them on to others. More and more subscribers have families who lived there and I'm embarassed that I can't seem to make many suggestions. Census records were few and far between and list head of family only. Can anyone comment on the level of cooperation when writing for information?

Just inside the back cover you will find a registration blank for attending a seminar in Sparta in Spril, at which Benoit Pontbriand will speak. When I learned he would be visiting us I realized that there were likely many people within driving distance that would like to meet him and learn from him, so I asked him if he'd like to do this. He readily agreed. You who have French-Canadian background know of him as the publisher of over 100 marriage repertoires of Quebec. He is an experienced genealogist and very knowledgeable about Quebec research. He lives near the Archives in Quebec and can inform you of the holdings, and will also talk about Protestant research in that Province. Jim Hansen, genealogy reference librarian at the Wisconsin State Historical Society library, has consented to also appear. You may not be aware that Wisconsin has one of the most complete reference collections of Canadian material outside of that country. Every time I go there I find a new section that seems like finding a goldmine. We will have a panel discussion in the afternoon and a question and answer session that should help many with their research. This is certainly not limited to those with French-Canadian background and should prove rewarding for anyone attending. We hope to see a lot of friends from neighboring states. Sparta is easy to drive to as it is on the Interstate, located between Tomah and LaCrosse. There are motels here, and either of the other cities is an easy drive in the morning for those who wish to come the night before. We will send you a map showing directions to the City Hall after receiving your registration.

Please note the rate increases for display ads and non-subscriber queries. Also, a request for Canadians to pay in US funds or the equivalent.

The National Genealogical Society has pointed out that the General Services Administration has issued orders to disperse many of the collections of the National Archives' in Washington to the regional branch closest to their source of origin. What a tragedy that would be! Address your protest to David Rubenstein in the Office of Assistant to the President for Domestic Affairs and Policy, The White House, Washington, DC 20500. Letters may also be sent to your Senators (Washington 20510) and to your Congressmen (Washington 20515). GOOD HUNTING! and the best of all to everyone in the new decade.

Readers are asked to please direct correspondance to the questioner; however, I do appreciate being informed of your solution so the query can be removed from the "hunt list". Remember that \*\* after the parents names in an answer means that their marriage and ascending line will be found in Dictionnaire Genealogique des Familles Canadiennes (Tanguay, 7 volumes) and/or Dictionnaire National des Canadiens Francais (Drouin, 2 volumes). Acadian lines may be found in Acadian Descendants (Jehn, 2 volumes) and/or Histoire et Cenealogie des Acadiens (Arsenault, 6 volumes). Extensions to lines are kept on the "hunt list" until the answer contains \*\*. Answers are printed because, in French-Canadian genealogy especially, one "found" marriage may provide the answer for many researchers. These are some of the abbreviations used in queries. No periods are used. There are no specific rules for queries, but some advice: mention a time era and place if you can. Long queries have been paid extra for the privilege, but more advice: they don't seem to receive the attention a shorter, more specific one gets. Do not use abbreviations when submitting queries - I will convert them to the standard used. If you are sending a number of queries for future issues, please submit each on a separate sheet. you want a query to run each time (which I think is very unnecessary) please submit it each time - they have a tendancy to get missed.

Attached to the letter is a nicely bordered form asking for name, address, occupation religion, military service, social or fraternal organizations, special interest, birthplace, birthdate, spouse's name, how long married, children, number of grand-children, father's name, mother's maiden name, country or region of family origin, significant or colorful human events in immediate family or in family history.

This was sent from Hyattsville, Maryland. Although I've not seen one of the books, I suspect this is of the same ilk as the Family Heritage Book. All of the elements are there, including the message of haste. I will not line her pockets with money just to satisfy my curiosity, but if anyone has ordered this book, I'd very much appreciate a description or copies of some pages.

Actually, I'm beginning to get rather angry with these schemes. There are many genuine family genealogies that have taken years of research and money to accomplish, and I'd hate to see anyone pass up an opportunity to receive one of those. But, more to the point, I hate to see someone make a great deal of money on a scheme like this. As I stated earlier, you can probably dig up the same information by using the phone book collection of a large library. Remember that the family crest outfit in Ohio was a large fraud operation - let's stop these before they get so large.

The key to any offer has to be to read every word and resist the temptation to read into it a promise that isn't there. For example in the letter (on page 55), consider some of the actual words and phrases: you have one of the rarest names (I have not known of any of these letters being received by families names Jones, Smith, Johnson, Melson etc); we have written to all the known Deters (my two brothers and my father didn't receive a letter, probably because they are listed in phone books of small areas that are not likely to be collected by libraries); we have written over 237 letters to Deters (they do not state how many answers they have received); your name was in the last record source checked (I'd bet this same letter went to all 237 persons); have been able to hold the cost (this may be so that you think you are getting a bargain if they don't charge you more). The same comments go for the first letter I printed on page 173, and you might find it enlightening to compare the two offers. Also, I'll mention that we finally got an offer for the Reisinger Family Heritage Book. It was dated January 2 and we had until January 30 to order.

Marriages in the parishes of St. Andrews East Anglican (1812-1849) and Presbyterian (1818-1850), County Argenteuil, Quebec. These are taken from the microfilm reel C-2905, which was a copy from the original and is available through Inter-Library Loan from the Public Archives of Canada. The copier made a number of errors, and at times the handwriting was very unclear. Although the names of the parents of the bride and groom were not stated, often the man's occupation was noted, and the place of residence of each. Baptisms and burials are also in these registers. This is being published to give a possible clue to the researcher who only knows his family was from "Canada", and also because there was such a mixture of Anglo and French names. Correction to the address given on page 111, Volume 5. The address for the Archives Nationales of Trois-Rivieres is 225 des Forges, Suite 103, Trois-Rivieres, Quebec G9A 2G7. I had written asking them to check a parish register for the parents of a couple who were married at Ste-Victoire. The reply was a form letter indicating that the civil registers of the District and the notary records prior to 1875 are at Palais de Justice, 250 Laviolette, Trois-Rivieres. I am still uncertain where the parish registers are housed.

As a follow-up to the items printed in LOSM? Volume 5, pages 173 and 234, I am no longer trying for politeness, but will call it as I see it. Unfortunately, many peorle have not heard the warnings. Suggested by a reader: "If we would like to help stop the Family Heritage Book rip-off, why not wrap up a brick, tape her postage-paid Business Reply Mail Envelope to the package, and put her out of business via the Post Office! Think about it." Quite frankly, I thought it was about the best idea I'd heard, but in checking with our Postmaster I find that it can't be done.

I must pass on a new warning. The woman in Sterling, Pennsylvania is not the only one. One of her customers must have decided to try to get some of this easy money for herself. The following letter was sent to my sister Linda (who is not married):

Dear Mr. Deters,

Did you know you have one of the rarest names in the United States? On the average there is only one Deters family for every half million Americans. At least that is all we've been able to find in the official U.S. government records.

We've been able to hold the cost of our other albums to around \$19.00. I can't promise that will be the price, with inflation and everything, but it will be near that.

You don't have to order the album to be in it. Eut, I would appreciate your reply as I want to make the Deters Family Mame Album as complete as possible for the other Deters families who want one.
