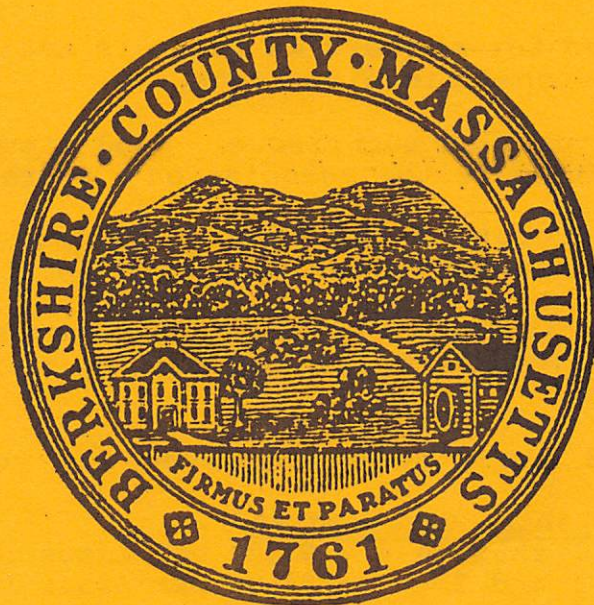

BOOK REVIEWS

A New Genealogical Atlas of Ireland. By Brian Mitchell. Paperback, 123pp., maps, 1986. \$18.95. Order from Genealogical Publishing Co., Dept. T.T., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202.

These 123 pages carry 111 maps, both spotlighting and facilitating the geographical knowledge needed for Irish genealogical research. Brief summaries introduce the reader to major administrative districts: Counties, Baronies, Poor Law Unions, Civil Parishes, and Diocese and to the record sources whose identification by location the maps aid: tithe books, census records, parish registers, and the Griffith's Valuation. The maps then lead one to, for example, the Baronies of County Downs (showing diocese), the Parishes of County Kilkenny, and the Poor Law Unions of County Monahan (showing probate districts).

Collecting Dead Relatives. By Laverne Galeener-Moore. Paperback, 155pp., illus., 1987. \$8.98 plus \$1.25 postage and handling. Order from Genealogical Publishing Co., Dept. T.T., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202.

"An irreverant romp through the field of genealogy" says the author. Sure enough - if you don't get a laugh in here, as the spieler used to say outside the "Fun House", there's something wrong with your laugh-eratus.

Comic, readable, and withal informative, small enough to tuck in a purse or carryall - this should be a fun companion for plane, train, or car passenger seat. As with many books of humor, you may find something here to offend (I cringed at "bloodthirsty Indians"). But all-in-all this is good-natured spoofing and genealogists will recognize those irascible and irritating types one encounters at the county seat and some libraries and archives, and even, perhaps, one's own lugubrious self.

American Vital Records from the Gentleman's Magazine, 1731-1868. Compiled by David Dobson. Cloth, 310pp. \$25.00 Order from Genealogical Publishing Co., Dept. T.T., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202.

The Gentleman's Magazine and Historical Review was founded in London in 1731 and ran until 1868. For the genealogist, it is an important source because, in addition to news, poetry, and anti-quarian notes, it printed from its inception columns of births, marriages, and deaths for persons both at home and abroad. The present work contains abstracts of the thousands of entries of vital records for persons in North America.

Alphabetical entries are followed by the information in the magazine and a citation to its volume and page.

Our Italian Surnames. By Joseph G. Fucilla. Cloth, 299pp., bibliography, index. \$20.00. Order from Genealogical Publishing Co., Dept. T.T., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202.

Whether you are of Italian descent, are working with those searching for their Italian ancestry or are a student of Italian onomatology, this should prove a rewarding book. Beginning first with given names, the author explores parental reasons for selection and, beyond that, how an Italian given name identifies them with the section of Italy from which they came. Following a chapter on the evolution of Italian surnames, Fucilla devotes chapters to pet names and to those whose names are geographical, occupative, botanical, animal, anatomical, and so on. The layman is always kept in mind, with a lucidly written book with all foreign phrases translated. If the magic of names touches you, this should be fascinating reading.

Biography and Genealogy Master Index, 1986. Edited by Barbara McNeil. 648pp. Bibliographic key. Order from Gale Research Co., Detroit, Michigan.

A basic reference tool for those needing to locate biographical material. It indexes biographical dictionaries, subject encyclopedias, volumes of literary criticism, and indexes of indexes, including such items as *Current Biography*, *Biography Index*, and the national, regional, and subject volumes of *Who's Who*. More than 65 volumes of such works are referenced here.
