

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ZENAS WHEELER, PRIVATE, MASSACHUSETTS LINE

The following is a synopsis of the National Archives pension application files of Zenas Wheeler of New Marlborough, File number S21569. Most of his affidavit was done on printed forms. [My comments are in brackets.]

On 14 Nov. 1832 Zenas Wheeler of New Marlborough applied for a pension as a Revolutionary soldier under the act of 7 June 1832. [This was the first act to provide a pension for ordinary soldiers who were not in financial need.]

He gave his age as 75, said that he was born on 22 Oct. 1756, that he entered the service in New Marlborough and that he had lived there ever since.

He said that he enlisted as a private for a one-year term for the year 1776 in a company commanded by Capt. Moses Soul in Col. Asa Whitcomb's regiment. He and the rest of the regiment joined the main army at Cambridge on 1 Jan. 1776 where they remained until the British evacuated Boston on 17 March following.

Then the regiment entered Boston to protect the harbor. They stayed there until the first of August [1776] when they marched to Ticonderoga. There he remained until 1 Jan. 1777 when his enlistment expired and he was discharged. He said that at Boston they were with Gen'l Washington and Col. Shepard.

Zenas Wheeler said that he could prove this service by Seth Hubbard of Sandisfield and Asa Cole of New Marlborough who served with him the entire year.

He then described another period of service in which he volunteered in the militia against Burgoyne's army, around 1 Sept. 1777. He was in a company commanded by Elijah Deming of Sandisfield, with Eleazer Taylor of New Marlborough as lieutenant, in Col. Ashley's regiment.

He recalled marching to Stillwater on the Hudson and later going up the east side of the river to guard the fort at Battenkill [Battenville?] until Burgoyne surrendered on 17 Oct. 1777. He thus served one and a half months. He said that at the "taking of Burgoyne" [Saratoga], Gen'l Gates commanded and Gen'l Arnold was there, and that "during the autumn Arnold's defect took place". [Elisha Allen, whose letter of 28 Sept 1777 from "Stilworters" was published in the Fall, 1988 BERKSHIRE GENEALOGIST may well have been in the same unit.]

Proof of this service was by an original pay record that had been found in the papers of Lt. Eleazer Taylor. Zenas said that

Seth Hubbard of Sandisfield and John Hyde of New Marlborough could prove this service also.

Rev. Harley Goodwin and Benjamin Sheldon, both of New Marlborough, certified that they were well acquainted with Zenas Wheeler and that they believed that he was "a soldier of the Revolution". Zenas signed his own application and was awarded a pension of \$45 per year.

[Zenas Wheeler doesn't mention his family in this application but we can tell by his date of birth that he was the son of Zenas and Azubah Wheeler and the grandson of Benjamin Wheeler, the first settler of New Marlborough. Benjamin Wheeler's grandfather, Resolved White, was a Mayflower passenger along with his parents William and Susannah White.

We can see from their gravestones and from the New Marlborough Vital Statistics that Deacon Zenas Wheeler died on 26 May 1842, "AE 85". He married Elizabeth Dodge on 29 Dec. 1779 in New Marlborough. She died on 17 May 1829, aged 70 years. He then married Widow Polly Cadwell on 11 Feb. 1830. She died on 18 Oct. 1841, at the age of 72. Zenas Wheeler lies with one wife on either side of him in the New Marlborough village cemetery, on the far side of the left-hand hill as you come in from the road.

All references to the New Marlborough Vital Statistics (NMVS) are taken from the typescript copy in the NEHGS library. Gravestone information was copied by me in 1985. The best reference for Benjamin Wheeler's Mayflower line of descent is "Mayflower Families Through Five Generations", Volume I, with Addendum, a publication of the General Society of Mayflower Descendants. Work remains to be done on the New Marlborough Wheelers: the maiden names of Benjamin Wheeler's wife Hannah and Zenas Wheeler, Sr.'s wife Azubah aren't known.]


