

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## BERKSHIRE WOMEN'S MAIDEN NAMES FROM PROBATE RECORDS TO 1860

Compiled by Glendyne R. Wergland

In the process of compiling a thesis on women's property ownership, I examined about 350 women's wills (nearly every one in Berkshire County up to 1860) and 150-200 men's wills and probate administration records, which is why women outnumber men in the TESTATOR'S NAME column.

I've done a bit of genealogical research, and like everyone else, I've been stymied by the lack of maiden names for women. Perhaps unlike most researchers, I was offended enough to do something about it. Even though this doesn't help me in my research, I hope it will help others. If anyone wants to volunteer to start extracting the other pre-1860 probate records, I would be happy to help, and will offer my existing database. My feeling that women have been neglected by previous generations of historians and town clerks is what provoked me to write down the names of 967 women unnecessary to my master's thesis research.

A few notes about the headings and abbreviations:

The first column, DAU-SIS-N lists the married names of women whose maiden names might reasonably be deduced from additional information in the probate record. It also includes a letter, after the name, denoting the probable relationship to the person who wrote the will. Women with no relationship designated were probably the daughter of the testatrix/testator. Other relationships:

s = sister	dil = daughter-in-law
n = niece	sil = sister-in-law
gd = granddaughter	? = relationship unknown.

In a few cases, the name of a nephew had been included, or a last name followed by dashes, to suggest the possible last name of a married sister of the testatrix.

An asterisk by any name means that individual also has a probate file that should be checked.

Searchers should check this data against the actual probate file, and not rely wholly on my logic. For one thing, my logic gets shaky after I've looked at a few hundred names, and there are 967 on this list. For another thing, there are additional names of male heirs at law in many of the probate files, and those may offer additional clues in genealogical tracking.

The second column, HUSBAND, is the husband of the woman named in the first column. In many cases, a husband was not named, but that doesn't mean the woman wasn't married at the time the will was written or probated. Customs changed as time passed, and later in the century, testators and executors were more likely to list a woman's name without that of her husband.

The third column, TESTATOR'S NAME, is the name of the testator whose will was examined. In some cases, a testatrix's probable maiden name was deduced from the names of her father or brothers if they were named as such in her will or in the list of

heirs at law. Many women who wrote wills were single, in which case their own marital status informs the reader of the probable maiden name of her sisters. In some cases, a testatrix's multiple marriages muddy the waters as to her daughters' maiden names. But there will be more clues in the actual probate file than in this list, which should serve only as a finding aid.

The other six columns have information relating to the testator/testatrix.

The OO column cites the marital status for women in some records plus occasional information on men:

w woman, marital status unknown  
 ws singlewoman  
 wm woman married at the time she wrote her will  
 ww widow  
 wd divorced woman  
 fm farmer (relates to women farmers in 1860 census agricultural schedule)  
 f father  
 b brother  
 h husband

TOWN indicates the residence of the testator/testatrix.

PBT is the year of probate.

FILE is the file number in Berkshire County Probate Court files.

WILL is the year the will was written.

SPOUSE is the name of the spouse of the testator/testatrix.

## THE BOOKSTALL

*History of Western Massachusetts: The Counties of Hampden, Hampshire, Franklin and Berkshire, Embracing an Outline or General History of the Section, an Account of the Scientific Aspects and Leading Interests and Separate Histories of Its One Hundred Towns*, by Josiah Gilbert Holland, 1855. 1994 reprint, 2 vols., 1180pp, softbound, 5½ x 8½, new index, price \$60.00. Order from Heritage Books, Inc., 1540-E Pointer Ridge Pl., Suite 300, Bowie, MD 20716.

The first volume is concerned mainly with the colonial history of the area but extends to Shays' Rebellion, the War of 1812 and initial industrial development. The settler-Indian confrontations for nearly a century are covered in detail with the names of many of the participants. The final third of this volume is concerned with geology, agriculture, railroads and educational institutions. There is a very detailed account of Shays' Rebellion and the circumstances leading to it.

Volume 2, the larger, presents histories of the one hundred towns which comprised these four counties in 1855. Both volumes contain the names of many residents and these are made accessible through an every-name index for each volume.

The author was a native of Belchertown and founder and editor of *Scribner's Monthly*, an editor for the *Springfield Republican*, as well as an extensive writer of histories, novels and poetry.

were of slate or ancient design. The oldest stones date back to the 1700's with information on the earliest settlers of the area.

Included are: Howes, Dennis Village (map), Hall, Scargo, Indian, Paddock, Worden, Quivet, Sears (map) Quaker, Ancient South Dennis, South Dennis Congregational Church (map), West Dennis (Maps of Parish Ground and Methodist Church sections), Baker, Wixon, Swan Lake (map), and West Harwich Baptist Church.

Dennis was the East Parish of Yarmouth until 1793 so this work represents a part of a Bicentennial activity.

The locations of the various cemeteries are given but some are not readily visible from the highway and some exploring may be required as in the case of Hall or Sears. In particular the Hall where long-time residents and a policeman patrolling the area knew of no cemetery in the vicinity of Corporation Road. It was a small boy on a bicycle guided us to it. This work will be of great value to anyone embarking on Cape Cod research.

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## NATIONAL ARCHIVES - PITTSFIELD REGION - IS NOW OPEN

The Berkshire Family History Association joins with the National Archives and Records Administration in announcing the opening of the nation's 13th Regional National Archives, a beautiful, brand new facility located at 100 Dan Fox Drive, Pittsfield, Massachusetts.

The National Archives and Records Administration is the federal agency responsible for preserving the historically valuable records of the federal government and making them available to the public. The addition of the 13th region to the system ensures a wider range of citizens access to these important historical documents.

The Pittsfield Region holds almost 60,000 rolls of microfilm records including U. S. Census from 1790-1920 (a library of indexes is available), Revolutionary War pension files, Massachusetts naturalization indexes, and passenger lists from ships arriving in Boston, Philadelphia, and New York from 1820-the 1950's, depending on port. The Region will hold the only complete set (outside Washington, DC) of the Imperial Russian Consulate records and the Kennedy Assassination files.

Also available are records in the following categories: Veterans Administration, District Courts of the U.S., Naval Personnel, Coast Guard, Weather Bureau, Post Office, Customs, Interior Secretary, IRS, Justice, Treasury and State Departments, Indian Affairs, Boundary and Claims, Adjutant General, Naval Districts, Supreme Court, Continental and Confederation Congresses, and the Constitutional Convention. Exactly what records are contained in each of the above categories may be ascertained by consulting the Region's catalog, *SPECIAL LIST 62 - NATIONAL ARCHIVES MICROFILM PUBLICATIONS IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES - PITTSFIELD REGION* which is available at no charge from the Region Office.

The microfilm reading room is open to the public from 10:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. There are 20 hand-operated microfilm readers, and two copiers. There is a cafeteria with a refrigerator, microwave oven and several snack and soda vending machines. Small lockers are available. Parking is just outside the main entrance, with about a 50 foot walk to the reading room. The building is handicapped accessible.
