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

AN 18th CENTURY FINANCIAL SCAM?

The first settler of Whitehall, N. Y. was one Major Skene. (Appropriately, the town was then called Skenesborough.) Maj. Skene had become acquainted with the place while accompanying the expedition under Gen. Amherst, in 1755. He built a 30 X 40 foot house, 2½ stories in height, and a 130 foot long barn, with massive stone walls pierced with portholes. The other buildings in the settlement were a few frail homes belonging to his tenants. He was very popular with the settlers, and hence he was an object of both fear and dislike to the Patriots. As he espoused the royalist cause, his house was taken in May 1775 by a party of volunteers led by Capt. Herrick. In the cellar of the house was found the body of the Major's wife, which had been preserved many years to secure to the husband an annuity devised to her "while she remained above ground". The Americans buried the body in the rear of the house. [From Historical and Statistical Gazetteer of New York State, 1860, published by J. A. French.

The North Pownal, Vermont schoolhouse had for teachers two successive winters, James A. Garfield and Chester A. Arthur, respectively. By a strange twist of fate the latter also succeeded the former as president of the United States. President Garfield had graduated from Williams College in Williamstown, Mass. in 1856, and President Arthur from Union College in Schenectady, New York in 1848.

state that Mrs. Hannah BARKER m Ezekiel DEWEY 18 Jun 1783. At this time the title of "Mrs." was often applied to women of thirty-five or so years of age. In my own lineage, Joseph Paddock m Mrs. Elizabeth MAYO. She was 37 years old at the time, unmarried and became his third wife. This custom was well demonstrated in a Cape Cod cemetery where we found three tombstones, side by side, saying in effect "Mary Doe wife of John Doe", "John Doe" and "Mrs. Hannah Doe 38 years of age, daughter of Mary and John Doe". This is only a lead and must be checked out as well as the suggestion that this may not have been the first marriage for Ezekiel. [JBC]


Dover was one of the first four towns established in New Hampshire and included the areas now occupied by Durham, Lee, Madbury, Newington, Rollingsford and Somersworth in addition to that of the present Dover. This book was first published as Collections Of Dover, N.H. Historical Society, Volume 1 and contains records extracted from 1693-1838 town records. Included also are extracts from records maintained by ministers, churches and private citizens during this period.

The New Hampshire Spy was a Portsmouth, New Hampshire newspaper published from October 1786 to March 1793. This book contains abstracts of more than fifteen hundred articles from The Spy. The flavor of the times is presented by election results, property for sale, fires or other local disasters, minutes of meetings, announcements of local organizations. There are marriage and death notices and land sale records containing genealogical information. Portsmouth as a seaport was the focus of many of the articles as well as the sailings of the ships from its harbors. This is an extremely interesting book.

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
