This monument is erected by the town of Pittsfield to commemorate the heroism and virtues of its First Female Settler, and the mother of the first white child born within its limits. Surrounded by Tribes of hostile Indians she defended in more than one massacre, unaided, the lives and property of her family, and was distinguished for the courage and fortitude with which she bore the dangers and privations of a pioneer life. A Mother of the Revolution and mother in Israel.

#### NEW CEMETERY, AND OLD BURYING GROUND

The Corbin notes state, "The following graves and stones were moved, circa 1890, from the old cemetery on North Street, on the spot where the Catholic Church (St. Joseph's) now is. There are three rows of these stones set about 6 inches apart. Only the bare facts were copied."

Correction: Mr. Corbin's facts on this subject are mistaken. The stones were moved, either from the "New Town Cemetery" which was in First Street in the area known as "The Common" (used 1830-1849), or from the "Old Burial Ground" which was located behind the Old Town Hall on Park Square (now a branch office of Berkshire Bank). After the opening of the Wahconah Street Cemetery in 1850, all stones from the "New Cemetery" on First Street and the stones still remaining in the "Old Burial Ground" were removed to the Wahconah Street Cemetery. There was never a cemetery located where St. Joseph's Church stands today.



#### Reviews by J. Bradley Cooper

The Ancestry of Dr. Franklin B. McClung, by Joan S. Guilford, PhD, hardbound, 9½ x 6½, 738pp, illus, pedigree charts, index, table of contents, bibliography. Price \$49.50 by check payable to Joan S. Guilford. Order from Genealogy Publishing Service, 573 Beasley Mine Road, Franklin, NC 28734-4144.

The Table of Contents lists 70 surnames to be covered by the text. Since many of the immigrants were Quakers, an introductory section presents material on the Society of Friends. Many came from Holland so there is a description of the Dutch naming system together with a list of the English equivalent of some Dutch names.

The main text presents seventy genealogies of varying lengths with citation of sources, while frequent excerpts from wills point up some of the family relationships. Where there is some disagreement as to specific relationship there is usually an analysis of the situation and the reasoning underlying the decision. Each genealogy is followed by a tabular display of the generational chain linking the early ancestor with Franklin B. McClung and Joan S. Guilford.



#### THE GOOD OLD DAYS?

Luther Taylor (1810-1888) came to Pittsfield in the 1840's as an engineer on the Western Railroad. In the fall of 1842 he had entered the employ of the pioneer engine builders Hinckley & Drury and worked for them on the Fresh Pond Railroad, later the Fitchburg Railroad. Here he met with an accident at Charlestown; when crossing a bridge his locomotive left the rails and he went twenty feet over into the water, but fortunately the tide was out and he escaped serious injury. When the company called on him to settle he was asked how far he fell, and he said "twenty feet" and that he would take three dollars a foot. It is reported that the company was glad to settle for \$60.00.
