REVIVING THE DEAD END

By J. Bradley Cooper

Certainly at the start of a genealogical project, but later as well, great reliance is placed on the analysis of data obtained by questioning those suspected of having appropriate information. This direct analysis includes the quizzing of parents and any relatives considered knowledgeable. The resulting data are analyzed and yield a genealogical structure upon which to build, as additional data are accumulated.

This method works fine for a while but eventually a point is reached where no one seems to know the identity of great uncle John Doe's wife. One source considers her to have been Sylvia of unknown surname. Another group considers her to have been Samantha, but of unknown surname. Finally, the place of their burial is discovered and visited. John and his wife are buried side by side but to our dismay the inscription on the wife's tombstone reads.

"Sarah wife of John Doe" - again no surname. A dead end has been reached.

Sometimes an indirect approach to a problem of this sort can yield a solution. Here a set of circumstances, and the people involved, is analyzed with the view of determining the several personal relationships of the participants. An excellent example of this is the Cooper/Slye relationship: Thomas Cooper came from England to America as a carpenter apprentice, settling in Windsor, Connecticut in 1634. At that time Springfield, Massachusetts was in the formative stage and administered through Hartford, Connecticut under the leadership of John Pynchon. As a result of the acquaintance with Pynchon, Cooper married and settled in Springfield. From a real estate transaction "in which his wife Sarah assented" at least her given name became known. Many years later a Maryland will surfaced. In this, Robert Slye mentioned, as contingent legatees, his nephews Timothy and Thomas Cooper of Springfield in New England.

The applicable portion of the will reads: "Should all my children die under age, and without issue, then I give my plantation called Lapworth Manor to my nephew Timothy Cooper, and Norwood, Lapworth Lodge and Clear Doubt to my nephew Thomas Cooper, both

of Springfield of New England."

Noting that immigrants to America often applied place names from home, a search was made in England for the place names of Lapworth Parish, Lapworth and Norwood. These occur in Warwickshire, England. The Lapworth registers record the following children of George Slye, whose wife is not listed:

There does not appear to be any New England record of a Slye family. There is no indication that Cooper ever returned to England which would indicate that Sarah must have made the trip to America for the specific purpose of marriage and that they were old friends. Considering the transportation systems of the day, it would seem that the two families were within walking distance. Parish registers record Cooper baptisms in Stratford-on-Avon and Castle Bromwich.

UNDERSTANDING THE CENSUS

The index books made to help the research of federal census records easier have eleven pages devoted to explaining why there are so many mistakes found on census sheets. The following are listed as possible causes:

- 1. How well educated was the enumerator? Penmanship, etc.
- Spelling by sound.
- 3. Multiple lettering.
- 4. Reduction of letters.
- Vowel interchanging.
- 6. Misformed letters or look alike letters.
- 7. Listing of ethnic names.
- 8. Nicknames and abbreviated names variations.
- 9. Voluntary and involuntary information from the resident.
- 10. Americanizing and aliasing of names.
- 11. The small "F" and "S" bloopers. (Jesse-Jefse, etc.)
- 12. Missing a letter or letters.
- 13. Resident not home. Neighbors answered questions.

Census lists of the years 1790 thru 1840 give the name of only the head of each family listed by the Census Enumerator. The above years also lists by number the males and females who reside with the family head in that house. Census years 1850 thru 1870 list all individuals in each home by name, age and sex but not their relationship to each other. Years 1880 thru 1920 add relationship and other things which could be useful to the researcher. There is a sheet with each census year showing what information was asked by the Census Enumerator. This sheet can be found by checking the Census itself at any Federal Archives. Space did not allow it to be done here.

Names in each ten year Census 1790 thru 1920 are listed alphabetically by last name, first name, line number and page number. Also for the years 1850 thru 1920 the residents of each household are listed in the same order as shown on the Census taken by the Census Enumerator; page, line, first name, last name, age, and place of birth. Each house listed will begin with [I] first name last name. From that name to the next [1] are the only residents of that house. The first name which has the [1] in front of it is listed as the head of that house.

The years 1870 and 1910 were the most difficult to interpret. When the name could not be read on any of the census sheets the line number will still appear on the index sheets with a question mark and possible the first or last name and gender of the individual. Every possible Town record was used to check names that were difficult to read; Assessors, Birth, Death, Cemetery and Vital records. Please note that as was written in the first part of this introductory that the spelling was copied as written unless it was so far out that it seemed best to help the poor dead and departed Enumerator write what he should have in the first place.
