## ISAAC MITCHELL, SURVIVOR OF SOUTHERN SLAVE DAYS, DIES HERE

Remembered Presidents from Jefferson to Taft and Many Interesting Incidents in U.S. History-He was Said to be 110 Years of Age-Escaped from Slavery by "Underground Railroad."

"Uncle Ike" Mitchell died at 4:45 p.m. Monday evening of senility and with his passing another of the small number of Saginaw's colored citizens who were slaves in the southland in the ante-bellum days was called. The deceased was 110 years old. By trade he was a bricklayer and in the pursuit of his calling met and became acquainted with many of Saginaw's citizens, both white and colored.

Isaac Mitchell was born in Louisville, Kentucky, as near as can be estimated, one hundred and ten years ago. This age is set by his wife, who survives him. No record has been kept of his birth but from his conversation and the topics he discussed which were contemporaneous, this age seems about right. He was born into slavery and on his master's plantation near Louisville learned the bricklayers trade and became proficient in it. So proficient in fact that he was let out by his master to other men to do their bricklaying for them.

### ESCAPED FROM SLAVERY

He had the full confidence of his master but was taken ill at one time and the family being in straitened circumstances, he was sold to another man. This new master he did not care for and he could not bear the changed conditions of his life, so he decided to leave and accordingly made plans for his escape. It was about two years after his change of owners that the life became unbearable and he decided to leave. He was frequently sent out on jobs for his new master, made out his bill, collected the money and returned and checked up with his overseer Saturday nights. One Saturday, however, after he had put in an exceptionally profitable week he determined to make the break for liberty and did not return to his home. Searching parties were sent out for him, his master not wishing to lose the money and a valuable piece of property as well, and accordingly posted a reward for his return. Mitchell, however, secreted himself in a pig sty and got in touch with his old owners, the son of the family holding "Uncle Ike" in great esteem. This young man sacrificed his southern principles long enough to give Mitchell means of escape which were a supply of food and two revolvers with ammunition for them. But the boy's father it seems would not have frowned

upon his son's failing for he gave his former servitor a fine rifle and whispered what was more valuable than many stacks of arms or tons of provisions, the name of that mysterious agency, "the underground railroad."

Uncle Ike lay in hiding for some time and on one occasion had to frighten off a party of pursuing 'poh white trash' by threatening to use the arms upon them. For a long time he lay in hiding until finally he go in touch with a Quaker family connected with the underground railroad, its members agreeing to put him over the route.

Accordingly he started from his Kentucky home, stole a boat and rowed across the Ohio River and met the first station in Ohio of the underground where he was hidden during the day, secreted on one of the odd Quaker conveyances and moved on to the next station of the line. Of old barns, deserted dwellings and most outlandish places of hiding where he was kept a most interesting series of tales were told by the old man during his life. Perhaps what would interest Saginaw people more than anything else is the fact that while on the Ohio bank of the Ohio river he became acquainted with W.Q. Atwood. This acquaintance which was most casual at the time, ripened in later life into a friendship. Mr. Atwood always taking a fond interest in "Uncle Ike" during the latter's thirty years stay in Saginaw.

#### SAFE AT AMHERSTBERG

The final stages of the journey were from Sandusky to Toledo and thence by boat from Toledo to Amherstberg, Canada. Arriving in Canada he was a free man and free to go and do as he pleased with the same rights of the white men among whom he lived. He went from Amherstberg to Chatham where he made his home for some years, later removing to Saginaw, of which he has been a resident for thirty years.

#### REMEMBERED OLD MASTER

Mr. Mitchell always had a warm place in his heart for his old master upon whose plantation he was born and could not bear to hear any one speak ill of him, or in fact he would hear no hard word against any of the southern gentlemen saying when the younger generation would rail against them, "They treated us all right, were good to us, but some of the colored people were so impatient that they had to be punished." He dearly loved the south, in Dixie Land.

As man he follow each president's career carefully and talked of them from Jefferson down to the present time, often told of the effect the different wars upon his section of the country and of the standpoint of the Canadians and sheltered Negroes who were in Chatham at the time of the great rebellion.

His knowledge of United States history was that of a man who had lived through it almost from the dawn to the present day and though he ran away from it at one time, he was intensely proud of the fact that he was born under the Stars and Stripes.

Isaac Mitchell was a member of the Latter Day Saints, becoming connected with that faith since coming to Saginaw. He was married 19 years ago to Mrs. Frances Milden of this city, who survives him. The remains were taken to Deisler's undertaking rooms. The funeral will be held Thursday, afternoon at 2 o'clock from Deisler's undertaking rooms. A clergyman of the Latter Day Saints will officiate. Further announcement will be made later.

GENALOGICAL EXCERPTS from "The Saginaw Enterprise"  
Published Tri-Weekly, Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday  
By Perry Joslin

June 18, 1859

Mr. William Townsend had the misfortune to have his leg broken yesterday, at Glasby's Mill. He was turning over a log, partly sawed, toward himself, when the cant-hook slipped letting the log fall, and catching his leg below the knee and breaking it.

June 23, 1859

Stephen R. Kirby tendered his resignation as chief engineer of the first department; accepted and filed at the City Council meeting June 20, 1859.

June 30, 1859

Married in this city, June 29, 1859 at the residence of Mr. John P. Derby, Mr. John J. Wheeler Esq. formerly of Burlington, Vermont, to Miss Sarah E. Gay, of this city.

July 2, 1859

Writ of Attachment against the property of Charles D. Bronson, sued out of the circuit court by S. Titus Parsons for the sum of three hundred dollars, on April 13, 1859; signed J.G. Sutherland, attorney for the plaintiff.

July 7, 1859

Died in this city, July 4th, Mrs. Sophia Filkins, wife of Moses C. Filkins, of congestion of the lungs, aged 31 years

July 9, 1859

Reuben Harper, a young man employed in the Merrill Mill, was seriously and dangerously injured on Thursday last. He was placing a band on some of the machinery, when a stick, which another hand was carelessly playing with, caught in the wheel, one end striking him on the left side of the abdomen, just missing the hip bone and coming out through the thigh. The end of the stick being smooth and rounded, it passed along by the main artery, without cutting it off, which it must have done had the stick been a sharp or rough one. It is hoped he will recover.

Report of the regular meeting of Excelsior Fire Engine Company #2 of the City of East Saginaw, convened Wednesday evening, July 6, 1859. Charles T. Harris had been appointed to draft a resolution thanking the ladies of East Saginaw and Saginaw City for furnishing garlands of flowers to decorate the engine and horse cart of the company for the Fourth of July. Robert Haddon was Secretary.

GENEALOGICAL EXCERPTS from "The Saginaw Enterprise"

July 9, 1859

Pioneer Hose Company #1 met on July 8, 1859, and adopted much the same resolution. Signed by J.Ed. Mershon, Foreman, Chauncey H. Gage Secretary.

Rev. W.C. Smith was to preach to the Congregational Church, held at Buena Vista Hall, Rev. McGee for the Protestant Episcopals, also at Buena Vista Hall, also at Buena Vista Hall, at a different hour; Rev. Curtis Mosher to speak to the Methodist assembly at the church and Rev. Conrad Volz for the Lutherans.

Orvil Hemenger of East Saginaw offered a \$10 reward of a black horse, about 14 hands high, strayed from the enclosure of the Hoyt Farm.

July 14, 1859

Guardian Sale: Henry Dean, deceased; minor heirs; Katharina M.S. Wiest, Fredericka Dorathea Hauge, Henry Dean, Marianna Dean, Julia Dean and Johanna Dean, dated East Saginaw, July 14, 1859; John Stroke, Guardian.

July 16, 1859

Rev. John Booth was scheduled to speak to the Baptist Church at Union Hall, while Rev. John Horst was to speak to the German Methodists at the Church.

An ordinance, passed by the City of East Saginaw, showed that the Sexton might demand and receive for his services of opening and closing an adult grave, \$2.50; a child's grave \$2.00 and a fee of \$2.00 for conveying a body to the Cemetery. This ordinance, as well as ordinances establishing the powers and duties of harbor masters and one relative to shade trees were signed by Willial L.P.Little as Mayor and Chauncey H. Gage as clerk.

July 19, 1859

A house on Jefferson Street, occupied by Mr. Lewis Arnold, was struck by lightning about one o'clock, during the storm yesterday afternoon. The fluid struck the gable end of the house and came down a few feet where it passed through an old stove pipe home into the room where the family were at the time, slivering a streak as it passed, and whent out in two places. Mr. Arnold and every member of the family were stunned by the shock, but strange to say, none seriously injured.

A fire department election was held to find a replacement for Chief Engineer Stephen R. Kirby, who had resigned; Franklin T. Hall was elected, defeating Samuel Allen.

**INTRODUCTION:**

These records are based on information in the State Archive of Central Franconia (or Mittel Franken) at Nuremberg. As a Sesquicentennial gift, the city of Gunzenhausen sent this information to its sister city of Frankenmuth, Michigan. Frankenmuth Historical Assn. translated the information, compiled these charts and, when possible, added a location & reference as to where in N. America the settler arrived (set off by: [ ]). **A Very Short Explanation of Reference Abbreviations**

(a fuller explanation can be found in the first issue of this series, Volume 29 Issue 3):

Intelligenzblatt fuer Mittelfranken (abbreviated "Intellig.BI.f.Mfr."), Kreis-Amtsblatt fuer Mittelfranken ("Krs.A.BI.f.Mfr."), Intelligenzblatt fuer den Rezat-Kreis ("Intellig.BI.f.d.Rezat-Kreis"), and Boten von Altdorf are official newspapers in which prospective legal emigrants published the fact that they were leaving Germany. The remainder of the reference is: the year, part (Beilage), number, column, and date of publication (the month is usually in Roman numerals).

"Reg.v.Mfr.K.d.I." is the abbreviation for "Regierung von Mittel Franken Kammer des Inneren" (Chamber of the Interior for Central Franconia, located in Ansbach), a department of the provincial administration. If one wished to see copies of the papers of Mathias Abelein, one would order them from the State Archive in Nuremberg, referring to, "Reg.v.Mfr.KdI, Abg.1932, Titulus Ia, Nr.57740/I" (the reference listed for that record). "Abgabe" (abbreviated "Abg.") refers to the year records were transferred to the State Archive in Nuremberg.

Other references indicate the administrative town near the emigrant's home (see the first issue for a fuller explanation of the various terms). If one wanted a copy of Walburga Abele's records, they would give the reference for that record: "LRA Eichstaett, Abgabe1981, Nr.676/1/4" (LRA=the office of the "Landkreis", called the "Landsratsamt", in this case the city of Eichstaett). If one wanted a copy of Joh. Jakob Ackermann's records they would give the reference for that record: "BA Ansbach, Abgabe1930, Nr.427/441" (BA="Bezirksamt", in this case the city of Ansbach). "Herrschafstsgericht", "Gericht- & Polizeibehoerde" and "Lg.ä.O." are other terms for types of administrative towns. In the "Hometown" column, the second town listed is one of these types of administrative towns. Unless noted, it is the "Landgericht" (LG.) of the first town listed in that column.
