#### ST. LUKE'S PARISH REGISTER

The Diaries of Rev. John McCarty 1853-1868 and Rev. Albert S. Nicholson 1868-1886

Reverend John McCarty started this diary in 1853 when he arrived at Fort Vancouver as Post Chaplain in the U. S. Army. In 1860 he founded the St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Vancouver and served as it's rector until 1868 when he retired.

Reverend Albert S. Nicholson followed Rev. McCarty as Rector of St. Luke's. He continued this parish diary until 1886 when he transferred to Tacoma.

The original diary was loaned to the Clark County Historical Museum in 1964 by Rev. William Peckover, then Rector of St. Luke's. Lesla Scott transcribed a copy of the diary and Dorothy Carlson helped with the indexing. It is that copy that is recorded here, by permission. Some of the entries were difficult to read and (?) indicates a question of interpretation or an illegible entry. Otherwise it is transcribed as originally written.

#### (Inside Cover)

The following Parochial entrees have been copied from my journal; and from a Parish Register of St. Lukes Church began by me after my return from the Atlantic States 2 Oct 1863, include my official acts, from the latter part of Jan (?) 7, 1853, when I returned on this coast as <a href="chaptain">chaptain</a> of Fort VanCouver, having charge of Trinity Parish Portland to the 9 day of Octr 1854 when I removed to Ft. Steilacoom to my returning to Ft VanCouver the 27 April, & my chaptaincy there, with the charge of St. Lukes Ch, in the city of VanCouver untill my final removal from this place, which I intend to make the 8 April 1868 –

19 Octr at Van Couver attended the funeral of Johnston a native of Sandweck Orkney Island aged 47 years --

On the 25 Dictr (?) at Fort Van Couver I solemnized the marriage of Michael F. Brook a soldier of the 4 U.S. Infantry to Mary Ann Kelly of the same place, persons present Lieut Dwyer & Hodges of the same regiment Sergeant Elderken (?) & wife -


Transcribed from original records of Clark County Courthouse. Extracted and typed by Colleen Curry Bennett.

All entries are by number, starting with #1. All names have been rearranged alphabetically for easier reading. At this writing a photocopy charge by the courthouse is fifty cents, however due to the old paper and handwriting as well as the book binding a clear copy may be difficult to obtain.

It is important to note the signature of the person filing the death return because the medical doctor did not always fill out the death return. At times a relative or close friend signed, sometimes identifying themselves, but not always crossing out the "M.D." on the printed form, therefore the "M.D." has been omitted after the signature.

Abbreviations used: male - m., female - f., residence - res., signature (s.), about - abt., --- - information omitted, ..., or question mark - illegible, father - fa., mother - mo., born - b., accoucheur - acc., widow, widower - wid.


