EARLY CLARK COUNTY SCHOOLS

WHY THE BELL RINGS

A History of the Salmon Creek
Elementary School

Compiled by Viola H. Stewart

Viola Stewart compiled this history in 1967 with much assistance from Margretta Zimmerman, descendant of the Goddard family. Joseph H. and Hester Goddard were among the earliest settlers in the Salmon Creek area. Much of the information comes from the diary kept by Joseph, and personal recollections of Dr. Henry S. Goddard, his son.

This article consists of excerpts from that history, printed by permission of the author. (If interested in further information, a copy of the original is located in the Clark County Historical Museum library.)

EARLY SETTLERS

"Silas B. Curtis settled near the mouth of Salmon Creek on the south bank March 5, 1851, being the first settler in the neighborhood." (Quoted from Dr. H. Goddard.) (Vancouver was still part of Oregon Territory.)

Silas Curtis was ... a bachelor. He was one of the early school teachers in the Salmon Creek district as well as in Vancouver.

Charles and Margaret Irby settled Nov 25, 1852 about 5 miles north of Vancouver. That means 5 miles north of the Columbia River.

Mr. Ansel Marble lived a short time $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Vancouver, just a little south of Andrew Quarnberg.

George and Susan Weigle took a claim Aug. 15, 1853 near the sight of Sarah. They had several children.

Jackson Brinn, who married a daughter of Weigle came to Salmon Creek in 1853. A little later they lived not far east of the Curtis farm. Mary was born Nov 23, 1853, one of the first children born in the neighborhood. Her first teacher was Silas Curtis.

Peter Haber, a bachelor, took a claim down the creek from Goddard's Sept 25, 1853. Fred Haber located Sept 23, 1853, east of the Tenney farm.

Joseph and Hester Goddard settled at Salmon Creek on Feb 1, 1853. Their children William was 15, Louisa 13, Charles 9, Ellen 7, and George 5.

William and Mary Ann Louisa Kelly settled near Irby on Dec 6, 1853.

On March 15, 1855 Abraham Gentis filed and moved to Salmon Creek April 6th. They had three school children. Gentis lived where Dr. H. Goddard later lived, then the Alexander place.

On Jan 1, 1855 John E. Messenger settled about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile below Salmon Creek bridge.

Ansel Marble moved north to Salmon Creek by the bridge where he built a sawmill in 1859 and a flouring mill in 1866. ...the Stage Coach Inn was built by Ansel Marble in 1865.

SCHOOL IN HOME

Joseph Hill Goddard must have been a very intelligent man but he had no public schooling. After he was married, his wife taught him to read and write. Hester was well educated for the time in which she lived and she wanted as much or better for her children. So in her little one room log cabin, with a lean-to and a loft, she taught her own children and the neighbor's for two terms. There were probably not more than 6 or 8 children of school age at that time. This was probably in 1853 or '54 and Hester's family had approximately half of the possible students.

FIRST SCHOOL HOUSE

(Dr. Goddard quotes from the diary of Joseph Goddard.)

"A school meeting was held at the Kelly house on Oct 7, 1854 and another meeting on Nov 4th with the result that on Jan 11, 1855 Mc Clure, Marble, Kelly and Irby were at work erecting a small log school house about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile toward Vancouver." (It was approximately where 99th Street and Hazel Dell Ave meet.) This was the first public school at Salmon Creek.

"The next day Joseph Goddard, Messenger, McClure, Haber and Irby were at work at the school house. It was approximately 12x14 feet." (Diary)

Hester Goddard taught in this log school at least two terms. Not more than 8 or 10 children attended the first term in this first school house. William Goddard also taught there.

"There are claims that the Providence Academy of Vancouver was the first school house built in the Pacific Northwest. It was opened in December 1856, nearly 2 years after the Salmon Creek school house was erected. Vancouver had schools prior to this but they were taught in various buildings that were not school houses. John Ball taught for the Hudson Bay Company the winter of 1834-35. Sister Louisa attended the Covington School on Fourth Plain (Orchards) the winters of 1852-3 and 1853-4. Mrs Covington taught in her own house."

The first Salmon Creek school served also as a community church.

ED NOTE: In checking the 1960 Census of Clark County (pub by CCGS) I found several of the families mentioned in this history, who in 1860 had children who had been or were going to be students in the Salmon Creek school. p 19, Silas Curtis, no family; George and Susan Wiggle (Weigle) with Daniel, age 26 and Solomon age 18; p 20, C.S. and Margaret Irby with James E. age 18, Amanda, 11, Katharine 9, John C. 6, Isam 3; p 26, William and Mary A. Kelley with Mary E. 19, Julia A. 15, Ann J. 10, James G. 8, Catharine A. 4; and together on p 47 with consecutive house nos. (i.e. neighbors) Ansel and Levisa Marrel (Marble) with Angenora 10, Flerenia 5, Flora 4, Francis S. 2, Levisa 6 months; Joseph and Esther (Hester) Goddard with Charles 16, Helen 14, George 12, Osa 5, Emma J. 2; William Goddard ag 23 with no family; John E. and Catherine Messenger with Hiney 6, Albert 4, Clara 2; James H. and Ann E. Alexander with Mary J. 11, Asa B. 9, William 7, James K. 5; Harvey 9 mos, Abraham and Mary A. Gustis (Gentis) with Charles 14, Levi 12, Iram 8, Elizabeth 2 mos; Jackson and Matilda Brinn with Mary 6, William H. 4, Sialas B. 3, Susan J. 2,

THE SECOND SCHOOL HOUSE

Since the school was not in the center of the community, a new school was erected about 50 feet east of Hazel Dell Ave. It was made of hewed logs, about 18x24 feet; was covered with shakes and had a puncheon floor. In each side there was a window of 2 sashes each, lying down, which could be slid back and forth for ventilation. A space 4x5 feet in the center of the room was without a floor and in this pit there was a large box stove with legs supported on some bricks. This arrangement was for protection from fire. The benches, mostly around the walls, were without backs. There were no desks, but for the teacher's use, a home-made table, On the end wall behind the table was a home-made blackboard, painted. A cloth was used for an eraser.

School began Jan 24, 1860 in this house with eight students and Mr. Taylor as teacher.

The school district extended to the head of Lake River, where the Powley children (1960 census - Christian and Elizabeth Powley with John 6, Ellen 3, Mary S. 1) came from, the Brinns from about the same distance but near Salmon Creek, the Andersons from 78th St about a mile east of Hiway 99 and from the east and north two or more miles.

Hester Goddard taught here two or three terms and Silas Curtis at least one term. (No dates) George Coffey was another early teacher. William and Louisa Goddard also taught.

For 17 years the young people of the neighborhood attended school at this place, from a few weeks to 3 months each winter. A few graduated before they finished our present first grade. Others persisted until fractions or proportion overwhelmed them and still others more loyal to the institution continued a little longer. Probably none went beyond the sixth grade.

Before school began some of the neighbors turned out for a day and cut a supply of wood. The schoolmaster received not more than \$30 a month for 3 months. He "boarded round" pro rata the number of children attending.

THIRD SCHOOL

A site was chosen on the north bank of Salmon Creek near the bridge. All of the labor was donated and on Jan 20, 1877 Joseph Goddard and Abe Gentis finished the building. It had a good board floor, board walls; (probably sawed at Walker's mill, about a mile up Salmon Creek.) and upright windows, but its greatest splendor was its sloping desks about 8 feet long, seated with benches having backs. Walter Sparks was hired for teacher and the school began on Feb 12, 1877.

On Dec 2, 1878 school began with Lettie Lyons as teacher and continued 3 months.

A. J. Webb opened school Oct 27, 1879 and taught for 4 months. Previously a term of school was completed in 3 months. On the evening of the last day of school, we gave a drama, the first ever undertaken at Salmon Creek.

FOURTH SCHOOL

After 10 or more years the school of 1877 became overpopulated. People began to discuss a place for a favorable location.

Mr Horace D. Tenney and his wife Ellen Goddard Tenney ... offered free a piece of land at the southeast corner of their farm (134th St & 20th Ave) for the purpose of building a new school. In 1894 they deeded one acre to district #18 for the payment of one dollar. This seemed to be ample playground space until 1915. With more students and with 20th Ave being cut through to the north that year the school was cramped for space. Another acre was bought from Mr Tenney at that time.

In 1894 the new building was finished. It was a neat wooden structure of planed lumber, painted on the outside.

The new school consisted of one large room at first with a small hallway and two cloakrooms at the front. All eight grades, if there was a child for every grade, were in this room and one teacher was employed. A few years later, when it became necessary to have two teachers of 4 grades each, a removable partition was built down the center of the room which could be set aside to make one room again for special occasions.

Church was held here as well as in all previous schools.

On the 20 of July at the same place I baptised the following children of James W. Bachelder & Sarah his wife, James Wm born July 21, 1849, Kate Pacific born Oct 10th 1850, Mary Bince born July 5th 1852 Emma Flora born July 4th 1856 Alice born Nov. 15th 1859 & Horace born June 8th 1859, the Parents sponsors with Capt. LIBRARY UPDATE

If you are unable to obtain books you want on interlibrary loan or travel to the distant library where you are anxious to do research, the next best thing is to write to the library. If you know the name of the book from which you want material copied, it is likely that the library will do it for you. Be specific in your questions and do not send money for postage or photocopying in order to simplify bookkeeping for yourself and the library. Do offer to pay for any photocopying and do send a stamped, self-addressed envelope (SASE). Ask the library to check for a family history of your family if you think your ancestors may have lived in the locality for a long time. Ask if the name of your ancestor appears in any local histories or family genealogies in the library's collection. It is true that many libraries do not have the staff to do research, but by making your questions short and to the point, you may receive something of interest.
