From the President. . .

The Pacific Northwest is blessed with excellent genealogical research resources. As I think of the various genealogical seminars which are scheduled for this Spring of 1983, I marvel at the excellent speakers who will be in our area giving lectures which will benefit all of us. Our own seminar on March 26th will cover four important areas: German, Norwegian research; Locating an immigrant ancestor; and Extending a pedigree line overseas. The speaker will be Marilyn Wellhauer. Olympia Genealogical Society is having their seminar April 30th. Their speaker will be Milton Rubicam. Topics of his lectures will be Pennsylvania and Delaware and Pitfalls in Genealogical Research. Eastside Genealogical Society in Bellevue, WA is sponsoring an Irish Genealogical Workshop on April 23rd with Donna Hotaling as speaker. The Puget Sound Genealogical Society has scheduled a seminar for April 30th with Arlene Eakles discussing Armchair Genealogical Research; American Court Records; Congressional Records; and Land & Property Tax Records.

In addition to these seminars and their valuable information, we have the following libraries and archives in close proximity where one could spend days perusing genealogical material: Clark County Genealogical Library, Washington State Library, Washington State archives, L.D.S. Genealogical Library (Vancouver), Seattle Public Library, National Archives (Seattle), Portland Public Library, Portland Forum Library, Oregon State Library (Salem), and Oregon State Archives (Salem). These are but a few of the larger holdings. Within the radius of a few miles, a genealogist can find excellent material in small libraries. If one is traveling further, come the summer months, don't pass up libraries along your way. Many have holdings of exceptional genealogical value.....one of these would be the Idaho State Library in Boise. I have done some research there and found it a gold-mine of genealogical material.

With these sources available to you, I hope they serve your needs to further your family research. Our own library is growing steadily in books, microfilm, and periodicals. If you have seen or used a publication which would be of value to our membership as a whole, please let Doris Wastradowski, our librarian, know the title and author.

Take advantage of the above. Not only will you enjoy the seminars and libraries, but you will benefit from each speaker and publication.

A B O U T C O P Y R I G H T S

The Copyright Act of 1976 came into effect 1 January 1978. (Title 17 of the U. S. Code) This general revision of the Copyright law is the first such revision since 1909. Copyright laws have existed in our country since 1790. Before 1909 the copyright laws stressed the rights of publishers whereas the laws today stress the rights of authors.

COPYRIGHT

Is the "sole legal right to print, publish, perform, film or record a literary or artistic or musical work." (Oxford American Dictionary)

It is a code of laws which legally protect the creative works of authors. These laws define what may or may not be copyrightable; what exclusive rights authors have; what limits are placed on their rights; the duration of copyrights; and how to obtain copyrights.

WHAT MAY BE COPYRIGHTED

Any "original work of authorship" that has been "fixed in any tangible medium of expression" may be copyrighted. The general categories of works that are copyrightable are: literary; musical; dramatic; pantomimes and choreographic; pictorial, graphic and sculptural; motion picture and other audiovisual works; and sound recordings. (Copyright Code)

An original work of authorship doesn't have to meet certain standards of quality or novelty. "Ordinarily, it is enough that the work is original to the author in the sense that he or she did not copy it." It is entirely possible that two people can separately create "original works" that are similar to each other. Both works would qualify for copyright because neither were copied and are original to the authors. (Johnston, p 12)

WHAT MAY NOT BE COPYRIGHTED

"In no case does copyright protection for an original work of authorship extend to any idea, procedure, process, system, method of operation, concept, principle, or discovery, or fact, regardless of the form in which it is described, explained, illustrated, or embodied in such work." (Copyright Code)

"The author does not obtain exclusive rights to the ideas that he or she expresses, only the right to stop others from copying the author's expression." (Johnston, p 12)

Also generally not protected by copyright are titles, names, short phrases and slogans; familiar symbols or designs; lettering, or coloring; mere listings of ingredients or contents. (Circular R 1)

EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF COPYRIGHT

The author or owner of copyright and those authorized by him have the exclusive right to: reproduce the copyrighted work in copies; prepare derivative works based upon the copyrighted work; distribute copies to the public by sale or other transfer of ownership, etc; to perform the copyrighted work

publicly; to display the copyrighted work publicly. (Copyright Code)
This list is illustrative and is not meant to exhaust the categories of copyrightable works. (Circular R 1)

FAIR USE

Limits on the rights of authors allows the copying of copyrighted material for certain "fair use" purposes. Considered "fair use" is reproduction for criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching (including multiple copies for classroom use), scholarship, or research. This is not an infringement of copyright. (Copyright Code)

WHO CAN CLAIM COPYRIGHT?

Once a work is fixed in a tangible form it immediately becomes the property of the AUTHOR WHO CREATED IT. Only the author or those deriving their rights through the author can rightfully claim copyright. Works made for hire belong to the employer, unless otherwise specified. Authors of a joint work are co-owners of the copyright. In a collective work, copyright of each separate contribution is separate from the copyright of the whole. If the copyright wasn't transferred, the owner of the collection copyright is presumed to have acquired only the right of reproduction and distribution of the contribution as a part of that collection. (Copyright Code)

TRANSFER OF COPYRIGHT The owner of a copyright may transfer any or all of his exclusive rights. The transfer isn't valid unless it is in writing and signed by the copyright owner. Transfer of nonexclusive rights do not require written permission. Copyright is a personal property right and may be bequeathed by will or passed as personal property. As personal property it is subject to various state laws.

The Copyright Office does not supply forms to record transfers of copyright. However such transfers may be recorded in the Copyright Office, but recording is not necessary to validate the transfer. (Circular R 1)

COPYRIGHT DURATION

Generally, for works copyrighted since 1 January 1978, copyright protection extends from the time of creation in tangible form, through the lifetime of the author and for fifty years after his death. For joint works, copyright extends for fifty years after the last surviving author's death. Works made for hire or are anonymous or pseudonymous (unless the identity of the author is registered in the Copyright Office), copyright lasts for 75 years from the date of publication or 100 years from the time of creation, whichever expires first. (Copyright Code)

Works created before 1 January 1978 but not published or registered for copyright are automatically protected by copyright under the new law. Duration of copyright is computed in the same way as new works - life + 50 or 75/100 rule. However all works in this category are guaranteed at least 25 years of statutory protection. (Circular R 1)

Under the Copyright Law of 1909, works were not protected at time of creation but from the time of publication or registration for copyright. Copyright lasted 28 years and was eligible for renewal. Under the new law, the renewal term is increased from 28 years to 47 years for works whose copyright were in effect on 1 January 1978. Application for renewal must occur within the year prior to the expiration of the first term of copyright. When copyright expires the work enters the "public domain" and is free for anyone to use in the U. S.

HOW TO SECURE COPYRIGHT

Copyright is secured automatically upon the creation of the original work in a fixed form. PUBLICATION AND REGISTRATION IS NOT NECESSARY. However there are certain advantages to having unpublished works registered for copyright. Registration establishes a public record of the copyright claim. It is usually required before any infringement suits may be filed in court. If made within 5 years of publication, registration establishes evidence of the validity of the copyright in court. If registration is made within 3 months of publication, or prior to an infringement of the work, damages and attorney's fees will be available to the copyright owner in court actions. Otherwise, only an award of actual damages and profits is available.

Registration may be made at any time within the life of the copyright. In the case of registered unpublished works, reregistration is not needed if the work is later published. (Circular R 1)

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Send to the Copyright Office in the same envelope or package:

1. A properly completed application form
2. A fee of \$10.00 for each application. DO NOT SEND CASH. Make a check or money order payable to: Register of Copyrights. Attach to application.
3. A deposit of a copy of the work being registered.

Deposit requirements vary, in general they are:

One complete copy is required if the work is unpublished or if published outside the U. S., or if the work is a contribution to a collective work and is published after 1 Jan 1978.

Two complete copies are required if published in the U. S. before or after 1 Jan 1978.

NOTE: use ink pen or typewriter and must be on forms printed and issued by the Copyright Office. The application forms become part of the permanent records of the Copyright Office and must meet archival standards.

FORMS ARE AVAILABLE, FREE OF CHARGE, FROM THE COPYRIGHT OFFICE

If the work is published with a notice of copyright, the deposit of two copies is MANDATORY within 3 months of publication. This deposit is for the use of the Library of Congress. Failure to do this makes you subject to fines and other penalties, but does not affect copyright protection.

If published in the U. S. a single deposit can satisfy both the deposit requirements for the Library of Congress and the registration requirements, if the copies accompany the prescribed application form and fee for registration. (Circular R 1)

NOTICE OF COPYRIGHT

When a work is published under the authority of the copyright owner a notice of copyright should be placed on all publicly distributed copies. Failure to comply with the notice requirement can result in the loss of certain additional rights otherwise available to the copyright owner. The copyright notice is the responsibility of the copyright owner, and does not require registration with the Copyright Office.

The FORM OF NOTICE should contain 3 elements: the symbol © (letter C in a circle) or the word "Copyright, or the abbreviation "Copr."; the year of the first publication of the work; the name of the owner of the copyright.

The POSITION OF NOTICE should be placed on copies of the work in such a manner to "give reasonable notice of the claim of copyright."

Notice of copyright is not required on unpublished works.

Omission or error in the copyright notice does not automatically invalidate the copyright of a work if registration of the work has been made within 5 years after publication without notice, and a reasonable effort is made to add the notice to all copies that are distributed to the public in the U. S.

NOTE: before 1978, notice of copyright was required for protection of published works. If published before 1978 without notice, all copyright protection was lost in the U. S. The new law does not provide retroactive protection for those works.

Death Index films for Washington and Oregon have been obtained for the Library and are there now for use by anyone using the facility. Washington Index dates from 1907 to 1979. Oregon Index is from 1903 to 1970. The Washington Index has a Soundex System for finding the surname. Instructions for this are at the beginning of each film. There is also a booklet entitled "Index To Vital Records" on the Washington Book Shelf next to the Vital Statistics. This booklet contains instructions on how to decipher the numbers, etc., as well as how to locate your surname according to Soundex.
