A 1910 Letter to Mary DuBois About Early Vancouver

Mary DuBois was born in Vancouver in 1880. Her family have been long time residents of Clark County. Mary was a teacher and had taught in Ilwaco, Vancouver and Portland, OR. She never married. In 1910 she was in Bellingham, Washington where she went to Normal School. The letter was written by Charles W. Hall, a lawyer in Vancouver, who later became a judge of the Superior Court.

Jan. 26th, 1910

Dear Friend Mamie: -Your letter came several days ago, but I have been so extremely busy that I have not answered it sooner. The old documents that I have been looking over have simply the old ordinances of the city, for which I have been preparing a code. . .

The City of Vancouver was incorporated by act of the Territorial Legislature of Jan. 23rd, 1857. The act appoints the following officers to hold office until election of their successors, which election was to be held on the first monday in November, 1857, to wit: -Sumner Barker, Joseph Brant, Moses E. Goodwin, John F. Smith, Gay Hayden, Samuel Marsh, and Henry C. Morse, Councilmen; Patrick Ahern, Recorder; B. L. Gardner, Marshal; N. Bateman, Assessor; Paul E. Eubank, Collector; and Henry S. Burlingame, Treasurer. The Council were to elect one of their number mayor until the election.

At the election in November of that year, Levi Farnsworth was chosen mayor; and it is he who signed the first ordinance, which was passed on March 16th, 1858, according to the records. This was an ordinance to forbid business on the sabbath-day.

As to claims, you no doubt know that the Donation Land Claim of Amos M. and Esther Short occupied that part of the present city lying west of Main and south of 26th Streets. The city park and public levee were given to the city by Esther Short, she having been donated the east half of the claim and her husband the west half.

The part of the city lying east of Main Street was settled upon and claimed by a Catholic Mission; but no patent was ever given them by the government. However they had sold off a great many tracts; so by patent dated Nov. 3, 1874, the United States granted to Abel G. Trip as Mayor of

Vancouver, and to his successors in office, the whole tract, in trust for the inhabitants and occupants. He or his successors then proceeded to deed to each claimant his own tract. Hoping there may be something in this useful to you. I remain,

Lawrence, city attorney. Due to resignations other members were elected: W. E. Hicks (city printer), Wm Tripp, J. H. Baker, Joseph M. Fletcher. In 1862 John Ariel became president and H. G. Struve became city attorney.

- Andriot, John L. Township Atlas of the United States. McLean, VA: Andriot Associates. 1979. An excellent township source, each state has several pages of maps. Also there's a populated place index and a list of civil divisions (did you know that 12 states have a Clark Co. and 5 more have Clarke Co.?)
- A Noble Son, Spencer W. Kimball. Salt Lake City: Institute of Family Research. 1979. Presented by Hazel Parke Hosington. A curious combination of cousins, this is an interesting set of charts showing relationships to famous people.
- Banks, Charles Edward. The History of Martha's Vineyard. 3 Vol. Edgartown, MA: Dukes Co. Historical Society. 1966. Vol I: General History; Vol II: Town Annals; Vol III: Family Genealogies. A thorough work, this goes back before Thomas Mayhew purchased "Martin's Vineyard" in 1641 for 40 pounds. Each vol. indexed. Note 1973 addenda in Vol. III.

LIBRARY UPDATE

"BITS AND PIECES".....THE RIGHT BIRTHDATE.....To compute the birthdate for a person who died giving only the age in years, months and days, subtract the days first, months second, years last. For instance, death occurred on July 4, 1886, aged 37 years, 7 months and 4 days: minus 4 days equals June 30, 1886; June 30, 1886 minus 7 months equals Nov. 30, 1885; minus 37 years equals November 30, 1848.

THE VALUE OF LODGE RECORDS.....If an ancestor belonged to a lodge, and you know where he resided at the time he was a member, write to the Secretary of that Lodge. The information given when he became a member would be:

1. Name in full
2. Place of birth
3. Names of parents

Earlier lodge records did not give this much information but later years are more complete and helpful.

FOR YOU who will be doing "SUMMER SEARCHING":

Census Records are easy to use; what can go wrong? Plenty, for both the beginner and the experienced researcher. Here are some negative ideas.

- Don't stop with the soundex findings; go back to the original census record!
 - Don't believe the census indexes to be either correct or complete.
 - Don't assume the spelling of the name is as you know it now.
 - Don't assume the relationship to the head of the household is as stated; Anyone found a listing of a niece-in-law, for instance?
 - Don't assume the ages given provide a birth year.
 - Don't forget to copy the information at the top of the page, as well as all the data to the right of the occupation column.
 - Don't forget to copy all the entries for your surname in the county. And better look over the neighbors, too. Four Smith's in a row with a Jones in the middle could easily mean a married daughter and her family.
 - Don't think the records before 1850 can't help. They may only have the one name listed but at least, you'll know how many to look for - for a whole family.
 - Don't think census data gives all the answers.
 - Don't forget the 1890 veterans census if your ancestor was in the military.
 - Widows are also listed.
 - Don't forget about state census records.
- The fact that there are 13 "don'ts" is no coincidence; any one of the above could mean bad luck. Have fun and good luck!

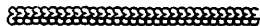

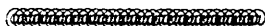
